SOUTH COLAC enter the 2022 season as flag favourites, but they won't have it all their way.

SOUTH COLAC have come so close on so many occasions since they last won a senior premiership in 2002. 20 years on, and they enter the 2022 season as the red-hot premiership favourites. After a strong 2021 season, the Roos have added some massive recruits. **Brendon Monaghan** and **Josh Woods** return to the club, while landing the **Presani brothers** and big ruckman, **Matt Garner**.



I'd be keeping my eyes on **IRREWARRA-BEEAC**, they went from finishing bottom-of-the-ladder in 2019, to finishing in the top three last season. I'm expecting them to continue their rise this season. They have added a couple of young guns from the Colac Tigers juniors,

but also gained back the likes of **Toby Middleton** and **Charlie Grist** from long-term injuries. Also added in young stars, like **Jack Barber**, **Jacob Stannard** and **Mitch Thornton** full-time into their side from successful junior careers. The Bombers have dominated the junior footy ranks over the last five years. We will see that talent now entering their senior team. They'll continue to build from last year, as the season goes on.



2021's minor premiers, **ALVIE** will again be a big player in this year's premiership race. Despite losing a couple of tough midfielders in **Pat Seal** and **Kaden Newton** their depth is way too good. They'll be able to cover their losses. **Dom Dare** at full-forward **Rosevear** and **Delorenzo** down back. The Swans could be forgiven for feeling aggrieved they couldn't play last year's final series, after finishing minor premiers.



LORNE have built their list back up again, with landing former Colac Tiger, **Alex Adams** as coach and have added a host of fresh new names to their side. They did finish outside the top five last year, but had one of the strongest percentages in the league. It might take them a little bit to get rolling this season, but when it clicks for the Dolphins, look out!



SIMPSON will be aiming to storm back into the finals after a couple of seasons missing out. They've landed one of the best footy brains in the district in **Daniel Beard** as coach of the Tigers. They also added some young class to their side this year. **Nick Harding** is fully fit and ready to launch into a big season.



APOLLO BAY, who have qualified for the last two final series have also had a strong pre-season

and will be aiming to continue to rise up on the CDFNL ladder. Great clubman, **Harley Soall** takes over as coach and will be aiming to continue the Hawk rise.



One of the great stories of 2021, was the rise of the **COLAC IMPERIALS**. A young team who surprised many. Can they do it again in 2022? The loss of big ruckman **Jordan Camm** is a big one, but they have gained young exciting forward, **Noah Allan** from Birre.



It's definitely a new era at **BIRREGURRA**. Sadly, we said goodbye to club and league legends, **Stephen Salajan** and **Sam Green**, but the Saints have loads of young and exciting players coming through the ranks, that no doubt coach, **Glenn Darroch** will play regularly. I wouldn't be taking the Saints lightly at all in 2022.



Could **OTWAY DISTRICTS** storm up the ladder? They have added some quality players and landed one of my all-time favourite AFL player, former Geelong Cats star, **Max Rooke**.



The **WESTERN EAGLES** will be aiming to not finish last again. They also have some pretty exciting kids, that showed so much promise last season. ■

MAX BLAKE: Congratulations on the senior coaching gig for the season, Harley.

What made you put your hand up for the role?

HARLEY SOALL: Thanks heaps. Kyle Briggs and I had a lengthy chat at seasons end and he told me the club would like it if I'd consider taking on the role. After a few phone calls and support from the senior playing group, I decided to take on the role.

MAX: How's your pre-season been?

HARLEY: The numbers have been great, the energy around the club and players has been very positive.

MAX: Most clubs just go on a road trip somewhere for a practice match. Yours was a flight to King Island! How was that experience for the group? How was the trip home?

HARLEY: As a club we have a strong King Island connection with current players like Will Cleeland, Brody Keeler, coming from the island. We thought it would be a great experience to try and get over there for a game. The experience for the group was fantastic. We went over with a young local side with the likes of Karl McSparron and myself being the older heads. It was a great time to bond and see who is ready to step-up into a leadership role. The

flight home was a little dusty though.

MAX: Who are some players to look out for this season? Any surprise packets? New recruits?

HARLEY: A few of the younger 'Bay boys are ready to step-up this season. Hudson Harrison and Will BG, Judah O'Donnell are in for a big season, along with Tristan Smith. Mitch Ash and Luke Morris are also ones to watch.

MAX: What about yourself? You've been a Reserves warrior for a number of years, dominating the goal kicking in the league. Will you slot yourself down forward in the seniors this year?

HARLEY: Haha, I'm a washed up 44-year-old. I'm still planning on coaching the two's alongside Shane Currie and provided I'm not keeping anyone out of the side, I might play a half.

MAX: What can we expect from Apollo Bay this season? Are you guys raising the bar pretty high on what you can achieve?

HARLEY: We're a side that's willing to push one another to get the best out of everyone from the 44th player on the list to the first. We're a united unit, something I've never seen in all my years down here.

MAX: Your season starts today, against Simpson. I guess it brings back some great memories [2019 Reserves flag]? How great was that day?

HARLEY: Honestly, one of the greatest feelings, ever. Back when we were the "worse side in the state", Simpson were a powerhouse and a side we had a lot of respect for. Throughout that year, we struggled to get our best team on the park and when we finally did, to win eight straight and finish as Premiers, was unbelievable.

MAX: Talk about turning things around! The club has done that right across the board, in many areas. From when you first arrived at the club to now. Can you tell the difference?

HARLEY: When I first arrived, the netball and football club had separated committees. It really didn't work very well. Coming together has bought everything together. Committees often get overlooked, but without them there would be no football. We're fortunate enough to have some great people volunteering their time to our sporting club.

MAX: Are you excited for the season to start today? Are you ready for it?

HARLEY: We honestly can't wait. It's been a tough few years for everyone involved with football. Two full pre-seasons, for only nine games. Footy's finally back! ■

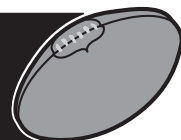

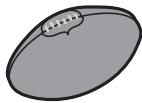

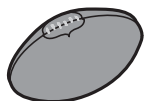

Celebrating 50 years of netball

This year, the CDFNL celebrates an important milestone.

In 1972 Polwarth Football Netball League disbanded and the Colac & District Football League accepted the following clubs into their competition: Apollo Bay, Birregurra, Forrest, and Lorne.

Netball was a very strong part of the Polwarth League and these four clubs decided to call a meeting of CDFL clubs to see if they were interested in forming a netball competition.

On Sunday, 26th March, 1972, the inaugural meeting was held in Forrest - attended by representatives from Alvie, Apollo Bay, Birregurra, Carlisle, Forrest, Gellibrand, Lorne, Otway Rovers, South Purrumbete and Warrion and the competition formed with 10 clubs.

This competition was named the Colac & District Football League Netball Association (CDFLNA).

Two division, Seniors and Seconds were agreed upon. Marion Mathews from Forrest was elected the first President and Kate Harrington also from Forrest was Secretary/Treasurer.

On Saturday, 15th April the first netball games were played within the CDFLNA, with 18 teams taking the court for the first round of matches.

Carlisle and Gellibrand were the only clubs not to enter two teams.
