After an injury, lockdowns and a cancelled final series, **Steven Cass** finally played game 150 for the Colac Imperials, last Saturday night. We spoke to him about it this week.

MAX BLAKE: After an injury, lockdown and a cancelled season, you finally got to game 150. How was the build up?

STEVEN CASS: Yeah, it was good to finally get there. The build up wasn't too much, we were more focused on just being round 1.

MAX: How was it playing under lights last weekend at Central Reserve?

STEVEN: We'd been hoping to have a night game for two years, now to actually play it, it was good fun. The weather was perfect and the big crowd made it a good night as well. It's just a shame it wasn't at our home, the Western Oval.

MAX: What's been some of your personal highlights in your 150 games? Any special games that stick in the memory? Any great goals you've kicked?

STEVEN: Playing in a grand final in 2013 was a great thrill, even if we didn't get the win. My favourite game would probably have to be the prelim that year against South. Also, a few other wins last year against sides nobody really expected us to beat... they're always good wins. Goals are always special that's why you've got to celebrate them.

MAX: Who has been some of your toughest opponents? Anyone that you've loved playing against?

STEVEN: I'd say the toughest opponent would've been Dave Marendaz. In my first few years, when we played South Colac, I seemed to get him on the wing. He just always knew where to be and wouldn't stop running. I always just love playing against the best sides, so you can really test yourself on the better players.

MAX: What's kept you being a one-club player?

STEVEN: Pretty much every Saturday in winter, since I was born we spent watching Imps. So, really there's no other place I'd rather play footy. My grandad played 200+ senior games here. There's probably 10-12 relatives that are Life Members here, also. It's always a great group of guys to run out with.

MAX: Besides the Western Oval, what are some of your favourite grounds in the league you enjoy playing on?

STEVEN: I've always loved going down to Forrest to play, and then probably Simpson is another favourite. It's a nice big ground to run around on.

MAX: I see you were at the SCG a couple of weeks ago when Buddy kicked his 1000th! How close did you get to him when you ran out?

STEVEN: I reckon we probably got within about 15-20m of him. It was a great experience being up there for it. Outside some of the Richmond finals I've been to, that last quarter was up there with the best atmosphere!

MAX: What about the Imps in 2022? A very impressive season last year. What are your expectations for this year?

STEVEN: Last year was a bit disappointing making finals, then not being able to play. So, this year, I'd be expecting us to be there, or thereabouts again.

MAX: Game 151 this weekend! Do you have your sights on getting to 200? 250? or 500?

STEVEN: As the saying goes, "I'll take it one week at a time." But, it would be good to get to 200. As I said before, my Grandad played 200+ games. So did my uncle Paul, so it would be nice to have a third generation play 200 for Imps aswell. ■

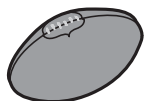
South Colac have been working hard over the off season, improving their club facilities. A few of their current players helped build their new coaches boxes, while the club also upgraded their new netball courts.

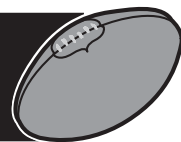

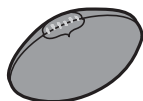
