





MAX: Who has been some of uour toughest opponents? Anyone that you've loved playing against?

STEVEN: I'd sau the toughest opponent would've been Dave Marendaz. In my first few years, when we plaued South Colac. I seemed to get him on the wing. He just always knew where to be and wouldn't stop running. I always just love playing against the best sides, so uou can reallu test uourself on the better players.

### MAX: What's kept you being a one-club player?




