## Lorne won the game, but lost the points

orne dominated the first-ever Easter Saturday battle, but all the hard work was for nothing. A jam-packed Stribling Reserve, saw Coastal Cup - rivals Lorne and Apollo Bay open the 2013 season and play in the first Easter Saturdau clash at Lorne.

The Dolphins started strongly from the word go, with Luke Norton kicking four first-half goals. Ross Waters dominated in the middle of the ground, kicking 3 goals.

Lorne would win the match by 65 points, but later found they had played an unregistered plauer, resulting in the Dolphins losing the four points. It mattered little though, as Lorne went onto win the premiership, while Apollo Bay finished in the top three on the ladder.

# The **Ultimate Battle 2013 V 2019** LORNE Premiership sides



Lorne have been an undisputed powerhouse in the CDFNL, since they entered the league in 1971. We rank and compare two dominant seasons - 2013 and 2019. Words MAX BLAKE.



#### 2013

n 2013, Lorne were avenging their heartbreaking 2012 Grand Final loss to Forrest. They appointed local star, Brock Sheils as coach, welcomed back Lewis Hollmer, Jaxson Barham, Che Turner and Tom Steven. From get-go the Dolphins dominated the season, suffering just the one loss.

(on the scoreboard anyway! - Check out our classic matches story on page 4) in the middle of the season against the Colac Imperials, but that win sparked them into further dominance, which saw them go onto winning the premiership.

They averaged 105 points per game and finished with a

massive percentage of 228.38.

Their highest score was 30.22 (202) v Otway Districts in Round 2.

Luke Norton kicked 58 goals, which topped the league's goal kicking that season, while Lewis Hollmer kicked 54 goals, on his way to winning the Mahoney Medal (League B & F).

#### 2019

n 2019, (our last premiership awarding year) the Dolphins were aiming to go back-to-back. Local star, Jackson Hollmer took over from Sam Stavenuiter. After an up and down start to the season, which saw the Dolphins lose a couple of close games. When it came time for Lorne to flex their muscles, they rose to the occasion, producing one of the most dominate Grand Final displays of the past decade. They averaged 107 points per

game. Their highest score of the season was 22.23 (155) v Otway Districts in Round 5. Lewis Hollmer booted 75 goals for the season (2nd in the league goal kicking), and Tom King booting 41 goals.

#### THE KEY MATCH-UP BATTLES

#### LEE HOLLMER (2013) v MARK McCORMACK (2019)

No doubt this debate would race on in the clubrooms most seasons, down at the Pod. But, for the two blokes in their respective seasons - big 'Chip' would get the points here. Mark's ability at the ground level was amazing in his peak. While in 2013, Lee was on the verge of his playing career, and amazingly, he played the season without an injury. The two have been absolute warriors for the Lorne FNC.

#### LUKE NORTON (2013) v RICHARD WHITE/JAMES FRIEL (2019)

Luke was a marking machine in 2013. He took some absolute hangers and was a reliable kick. I don't think the two key defenders, Richard or James would be able to stop Luke, who was in his absolute peak form in 2013. But, they also had Lewis Hollmer to deal with as well.

#### JAXSON BARHAM (2013) v MITCH McKEE (2019)

This would have been a great battle to see. Both have explosive pace and a killer kick. McKee was one of the best left foot midfielders I've seen that has come to the league. He was the perfect mid-season recruit that the Dolphins needed in 2019, and I reckon he would win this battle against the former Collingwood star.

#### **RYAN EVANS** (2013) v SEAN SMARTT (2019)

No doubt these two would have locked horns in the training park in their match sims. Ryan, was an amazing small forward with a really great ability to take contested marks and was a dead-eye in front of the goals. I think he would've had the edge on Sean in this battle.

#### **BOE TRICKEY** (2013) v TOM KING (2019)

I reckon Boe would have got the job done against Tom in this duel. Again, this would've been a great head-tohead contest. Tom, was an amazing young talent, who was an absolute dead-eye at any angle in front of the goals. But, Boe was an excellent defender, who had a great ability to run-off his man and rebound the ball outside his defensive 50.

#### WHO WINS?

#### 2013 v 2019

Lorne's 2013 season was the best I've seen in mu time covering the CDFNL - that includes seeing the Irrewarra-Beeac, Simpson and Birregurra dominate eras. The Dolphins just had winners everywhere.



MAX BLAKE: It's great to have a plauer of uour calibre back in the CDFNL. How have you found uour short time back in the league so far?

LEVI DARE: It's been great just to be back at the club where I started, and obviously to be able to be out there with my brothers just tops it off.

MAX: You've coached a few teams during your footy iourneu, and had a few coaches yourself. How are you finding it, playing under uour brother?

LEVI: Joe is very good at what he does. When he speaks, everyone listens. I was fortunate enough to see him play his best footy. He always had the ability to read the game better than anyone else, and he has that same ability as a coach.

#### MAX: How have you found the standard of the league?

LEVI: The two games we've had to start this year have been quite good. Both 'Warra and South have quality players that have played higher levels of football, which certainly elevates the standard, when you've had that experience.

MAX: How were the nerves when Mick Embreu had that shot on the siren last week? LEVI: 'Magic' is a good player and has been for a long time. You'd probablu back him in to kick it. I actually stood the mark, and he shanked it off the boot. It looked certain to be a point, but it started to swing back in the last few metres of flight. Lucky for us, it just clipped the top of the post.

MAX: You and 'Magic' were teammates in Colac's onlu GFL flag, almost a decade ago. Can uou believe it's been that long? Do you have manu memories from that day?

LEVI: It's hard to believe that it's closing in on 10 years since the flag with Colac. Plenty of memories of the dau, and the season leading up to it. The thing for me looking back, is that it was a team of local guys. The majority of which had come up plauing with and against each other in the CDFNL. That also came together to be the best team in country football. The standard of the GFL in 2014 was arguably the best that country football has seen. Also, to be able to share that with mu brother, Joe was pretty special.

#### MAX: Max: What ultimately got you back to playing at Alvie?

LEVI: Ultimately, it was just the chance to play with my brothers back at the club, where I played my junior footy.



#### MAX: What's the club like now, compared to when you were a junior?

LEVI: It's still got that great family club vibe that it's always had. The senior plauers seem a lot younger now than they did when I was the 15-year-old running out. But, it's great to see a lot of those guys are still involved in the club.

#### MAX: Is this your last dance, or do you think you have plenty of footy still left in you?

LEVI: For me. it's always been a competitive thing. The day I no longer have that drive to get out there and compete, and give everuthing on the day to help the team win, is the day I'll hang them up. But, right now I still love the contest as much as ever

#### MAX: You've played in some big games, but this weekend at a packed Lorne will be a ripper. Are you looking forward to the challenge? When was the last time you played down at Stribling Reserve?

LEVI: Yes, I think as a club we are very much looking forward to the challenge of taking on a strong Lorne outfit on their home turf. The last time I played down there, was one of my last games for Alvie, in early 2006, before I crossed to Colac. As I was part of the Geelong Falcons, they'd requested I play some GFL footy, so they could get a better look at my game.

MAX: One last one... and it's a cracker! Who's the best Dare boy at cricket, and the best at footy?



LEVI: Lincoln will argue this one to death, but if you take all of us at our peaks, we don't get close Joe's ability. He's the best I've played with - in probably both sports. Some of the things he did at Cobden in 2012, when he won the league medal for the HFNL.

I've not seen anyone match. It's a shame the guus he coaches now never got to see it. In cricket, he won three straight league medals, and never trained once. He just turned up and plaued. So, I don't think there's much arquing there.


