200 up for LORNE *Clubman*

Easter Saturday was a special day for one of Lorne's favourite sons. **Sean Smartt** played game 200, and we spoke to him in the aftermath. Words **MAX BLAKE**.

MAX BLAKE: Congratulations on the 200 game milestone. Has it come up pretty quick?

SEAN SMARTT: I guess so, I mean I can still remember my first senior game, and that seems like yesterday.

MAX: How did you go that day?

SEAN: I think I had three touches. It was out at Western Eagles, and we got beaten.

MAX: I have to bring this up. You’re a traditional long sleeve jumper wearer, but you went with the short sleeve in your milestone game. Why?

SEAN: I have a 25+ degree heat policy. If it’s over that, I don the short sleeve, and we don’t get many days like that in the year!

MAX: What have been some of the highlights during your 200 games?

SEAN: I’d have to say, playing in and winning grand finals. I mean that’s why we play footy. Nothing beats that winning feeling.

MAX: Which of the premierships was the best one?

SEAN: They’re all special! The first one was pretty good. After losing two before that, the winning feeling is a lot better than losing that’s for sure.

Beating Birregurra in 2018 was pretty good, when no one gave us a chance. They’re all special in their own way.

MAX: You’re warrior of a player. You would’ve had some great battles with other players. Who have been some of the toughest you’ve faced?

SEAN: In my early days, Andrew Kelly, Khan Beckett, Tyson Holt and Adam Harris. They were all learning experiences, playing on them. They were all just so good, and smart. I learnt a lot from following them. These days, when I’m too slow to play in the midfield, Paul Ridout is very silky, smart footballer. Josh Black, just doesn’t stop and a couple of weeks ago, I got to see first first hand, just how good Dom Dare is.

MAX: What about teammates? Lorne has been blessed to have had some great players come through the club. Who’s been some of your best teammates?

MAX: I can’t go past big ‘Chippa’ (Mark McCormack). He’s the Energizer bunny, you just know what you’re going to get from him every week. In saying that, I’ve played along side some pretty handy teammates, like the Hollmers, Jack and Tom Steven, Barham, Tully, Holroyd

and Courtts... and my little brother, Kane wasn’t too bad, either! I’ve been pretty fortunate to play along side some bloody good players.

MAX: What are some of your favourite grounds to play on in the league? Do you have a particular ground you love playing on?

SEAN: I don’t mind playing at Birregurra. Maybe it’s because I use to get the odd kick out there. But, I can’t go past Central Reserve, maybe because you know what’s at stake, if you win there.

MAX: It’s the Coastal Cup, this weekend. What’s the rivalry like between these two clubs nowadays?

SEAN: It’s definitely still there. No matter where each side is on the ladder, the game is always a good one. The new guys aren’t too familiar with the history of it, but it’s a special occasion every time we play. A lot of the older club people make it known just how much it means to them, and the club always goes out there to get the win against them.



MAX: A controversial one to finish with. Name the best Hollmer, Steven and Smartt brothers.

SEAN: I think Lee was the best Hollmer. Someone you’d want in the trenches with you. I’d pay good money to see him and ‘Chip’ go head-to-head.

Jack obviously is the best Steven, but George was pretty dominant in 2018, and Ted in 2013. As for Smartt’s, as much as it will make his head grow, it’s ‘Kaneo’. His determination and want to get the footy is a pretty special attribute. ■
