





TURNAROUND ////

Can Otway Districts make the top 5? Words MAX BLAKE.



It seems pretty silly to compare Colac and District Football Clubs to big-time NFL franchises, but a lot of clubs should take note of the Cincinnati Bengals story. I follow the Bengals in the NFL and they've been a laughing stock of the comp. for years. A strong organisation off-field, with a huge supporter base, they had simply gotten used to losing.

In the 2019 season, the Bengals recorded the worst season by any NFL side in the last 20 years! Two years later, they made the SuperBowl. They didn't tear the walls down and replace the whole list. Instead, they brought in a few good people to their team - both on and off the field and quickly changed their losing culture. I see a lot of sides currently struggling in local footy, but it can turn around - and it can be done quickly if you do it right.

This year, we've seen improvement from a couple of sides who had struggling seasons last year. Otway Districts struggled to score last year, but now sit sixth on the ladder, with a 3-2 win/loss record. While Simpson finished eigth last year and look like a real surprise packet this seson.

Over the years in the CDFNL, we've had teams rocket up the ladder, after having a poor year, the previous. Here are a few in recent times.

IRREWARRA-BEEAC - 2021

PREVIOUS FINISH: 10th (last)

2021 FINISH: 3rd

People forget that Irrewarra-Beeac finished last in 2019. But with a handful of new recruits and playing some of their talented juniors and coached by a bloke who is a great person and has a good footy brain in Cam Parker, the Bombers are now a real premiership threat again in the CDFNL.

APOLLO BAY - 2019

PREVIOUS FINISH: 6th 2019 FINISH: 3rd

The Hawks hadn't made the finals since 2013, but we're slowly progressing up the ladder. GDFNL star Brent McLoed was hired as coach and took the Hawks from second last to sixth, and then onto a preliminary final. In that final the Hawks were 40 points up in the second term, but were overrun in the end by South Colac.

SIMPSON - 2014

PREVIOUS FINISH: 9th 2014 FINISH: 1st

The Tigers stormed up the ladder in 2014 and won the flag. After playing in the final series from 2010-12, the Tigers had a lean year in 2013. They lost a few players to injury and departures to other clubs, but Adam Courtney returned to the club to take the reins. He brought back some of their young talent and won the flag by a CDFNL Grand Final record-winning margin.

APOLLO BAY-2013

PREVIOUS FINISH: 9th 2013 FINISH: 3rd (lost in straight sets)

The 'Bay were going through a seriously rough patch. They hadn't made the finals since 2005 and in 2011 they went winless. But in 2013 they turned things around and rose up the ladder.

SOUTH COLAC - 2011

PREVIOUS FINISH: 6th 2013 FINISH: 2nd

Prior to 2011, the Roos has only made the finals once, since 2003. During the previous season they'd won only seven games. The Roos recruited well during that off-season, landing the likes of Ben Cox, Daniel Roberts, Josh Goonan and with Stephen Hammond as coach, South Colac have not missed the finals since.

LORNE - 2006

PREVIOUS FINISH: 9th 2006 FINISH: 1st

The Dolphins only won four games in 2005, but stormed up the ladder in 2006, finishing minor premiers. In the Grand Final, they knocked off highly-fancied, Irrewarra-Beeac by 62 points. Future AFL players, Jack Steven and Jaxon Barham would feature in their flag win that season.

OTWAY DISTRICTS - 2004

PREVIOUS FINISH: 9th 2004 FINISH: 3rd

The Demons went from winning only three games in the 2003 season, to finish fourth at the end of the home and away season in 2014 and winning their way to the preliminary final. Otway Districts won finals against Irrewarra-Beeac and Western Eagles then were defeated by Lorne in the preliminary final.

FORREST - 2002

PREVIOUS FINISH: 8th 2002 FINISH: 3rd

The Lions only won just the 5 games in 2001, but stormed up the ladder in 2002, to go on and lose the preliminary final to South Colac by eight points.

Watch out for MITCH!



Irrewarra-Beeac young gun, **Mitchell Thornton** is impressing early in his senior career. We spoke to him during the week. Words **MAX BLAKE**.

MITCHELL THORNTON: It's been a solid start to the season for you Mitch, how have rated your year, so far?

MITCH THORNTON: I reckon I've started the year okay. I've just been trying to play my role, and to keep trying to help the team win games.

MAX: How have you found the transition from junior to senior footy?

MITCH: It obviously becomes a very different game, but all the boys and coaches around me have helped out heaps, which has made the transition a lot easier.

MAX: What's your main role in the side? Do you have a bit of free range out there to just go in and get the footy?

MITCH: At the moment I'm playing both in the midfield

and high half-forward.
Definitely, yes! Whilst still
sticking to team structure and
that type of stuff, but I know I'm
allowed to just play off instinct,
and try to find the footy when
I can.

MAX: What's the most difficult part of playing senior footy for you?

MITCH: Probably how all the hits and bumps are a bit bigger than they used to be. So I'm definitely feeling a bit sorer throughout the week.

MAX: What do you do to recover each week?

MITCH: Usually on a Sunday I like to go for a walk, or play basketball in my backyard. Just anything at a low intensity that gets me moving, and then throughout the week I might go to pool, or try to fix up any

areas that are still pretty sore from the previous week.

MAX: Is there any type of AFL player or other local footballer you model your playing style like?

MITCH: Not particularly, but I do really like watching Clayton Oliver play. So, maybe him a bit.

MAX: You were part of a pretty successful junior career at 'Warra. I know you've won a few flags, but do you feel robbed of a couple as well?

MITCH: Yes, I've been pretty lucky to play in a few successful teams over the years. I wouldn't say we were robbed of any flags. But, maybe unlucky we didn't get to play a few seasons when we had good sides, but that's the same for a lot of other teams as well.

MAX: Do you have a favourite premiership?

MITCH: Probably the Under 18's premiership, a couple of years ago, because that year was a lot of fun playing in a very talented team.






