





Your club's third of a season review in three words! Words MAX BLAKE.

e've reached one third of the season and so far it's been a great ride. We've had upsets, inspired wins, big goal bags and plenty of highlights. This year's CDFNL premiership race is wide open. Inspired by one of my favourite AFL media commentators - Kane Cornes, we sum up where each CDFNL team is at in a 'Three Word Game'.



ALVIE "DARE TO DREAM"

It's been a wild start to Alvie's 2022 season. They've had some great wins, including their Easter Saturdau miracle when the club was struck down bu Covid-19. but it's been the **Dare brothers** who have been performing well. Dom. up forward leads the 'CDFNL Coleman': Levi in the ruck: Linc in the middle plauing like Patrick Crips and Joe coaching like Tom Haffey. The Swans are in a great position to break their drought and win their first flag in 22 years.

APOLLO BAY "ROUGH TOUGH START"

It's fair to say the Hawks start to the season has been a disappointing one for their faithful. They've been hit hard with injuries and form, but the shining light is they've been able to blood some fresh young talent. They still have some absolute guns in their line-up and could prove to be a tough team to play in the second half of the season, if they can manage to get everyone back, fit and firing.

BIRREGURRA "HAVING A CRACK"

The Saints might be winless, but besides one game they've been in the fight in every match they've played. Birregurra have gone down the youth re-build path and it's working well. They're having a serious crack each week and have been unlucky not to have two or three wins on the board by now.

COLAC IMPERIALS "BUY STOCKS NOW"

The Cats are exciting to watch – fast, skillful and very well coached. The Colac Imperials have had a great start to the season. Their win against Alvie at Red Rock showed they can match it with the best sides. If you're a neutral following the league, get on them for the next few years. If they can keep this group together they can certainly go places.

IRREWARRA-BEEAC "WARRA WE COME"

After dropping the opening two games, Irrewarra-Beeac has stormed back up the ladder, with some big wins. They also matched it last weekend with flag favourites, South Colac to draw the match. They've got a great balance of experience mixed with young talent. This team will continue to improve as the season goes on and are a serious flag threat.

LORNE "THE SLEEPING GIANT"

The Dolphins have had an impressive start, but are they rated as much as South Colac and Alvie? Time will tell, but I think they are tracking very nicely. The Dees have impressed everyone so far this season. They've recruited well, but the biggest improvement to their game has been their fitness. In the past Otway Districts always dropped off at the sharp end of quarters, however this season they are over running sides. Clearly, the great Max Rooke has been working hard with this group. It's going to be exciting to see just how far they can go this season.

SIMPSON "YOUNG IMPRESSIVE CUBS"

Simpson have shown promise with some impressive results, but have also found it tough against a couple of the really good sides of the comp. Their young players they've brought in have been great and will be a dangerous side, any week. A return to the finals isn't off the table.



SOUTH COLAC "DEPTH IS BUILDING"

The Roos entered this season as the flag favorites, and have started with all guns blazing as many expected. They've been building their depth through their seniors and reserves sides to make a big charge towards the finals. Both their senior and reserves teams are currently in the top two, which history shows is a key to any premiership side.

It's been another tough start to the season for the Western Eagles. They've suffered some big losses and were hit hard with the 'spicy cough' (Covid-19). But, 'Big H' has a good side on paper and they are very close to it clicking and all coming together for their first victory. This week, we spoke to Western Eagles up-and-coming youngster Elijah Reid. Words MAX BLAKE.





MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us today, Elijah. How have you rated your start to the season?

ELIJAH REID: Obviouslu, it hasn't been the start to the season that we were looking for, but there's some really positive signs coming with our group aswell.

MAX: How have you rated uour form. mate? You seem to have slotted into senior footy pretty well.

ELIJAH: Yeah, not too bad. The position I play allows me to be

around the ball a fair bit, which helps me. Switching from juniors to seniors was definitely made easier by being able to play a few senior games throughout last year. That's probably helped my footy this year.

MAX: Last year, you were switching from the two and even sometimes playing both on the same dau. Has it helped your game, just focusing on senior footy this year?

ELIJAH: Yeah, probablu, It's a different game at senior level. It's been easier just focusing on one group of lads this year.

MAX: Your probably the uoungest ruckman in the comp. How do you prepare yourself to take on the big guys?

ELIJAH: I don't know, I just love the challenge because it's fair to say I'm probably undersized for a ruckman. I've enjoyed playing against some of the more experienced rucks in the league and it's helped my game.

MAX: Who's been your toughest opponent, so far this year?

MAX: What's uour recoveru like after a senior game, compared to playing in the juniors? Is there anything in particular you do to help you recover for the next game?

ELIJAH: Yeah, normally I try to get to a pool, or the beach sometimes of a Sunday, as a bit of recoveru.

MAX: Along with yourself, who do you think are the next young stars at the Western Eagles to look out for?

ELIJAH: The Eagles have got plenty of awesome juniors coming through, but Tully Borgia and Jack Fish are two to look out for soon.

MAX: You guys were close on the weekend to scoring your first win. It's been a rough start, but do think you guys are starting to gel as a side?

ELIJAH: Yeah, definitely. We've added a couple of experienced guys to the side in the past couple weeks, which has helped to steady us up as a team. We're shattered we couldn't get it done on the weekend, though.


MAX: What makes the Western Eagles a great club to be a part of?


