CDFNL *Penalty* SHOOT-OUT

The Socceroos got the job done last Tuesday, which has inspired us for this week's Max's Saturday Yarn.

I got up at 5am on Tuesday and sat on the edge of my couch for 130 minutes watching the Socceroos attempt to gain a spot in the Soccer World Cup. Similar to the 2006 qualifications, Australia went into penalty shoot-outs and prevailed. It was a fantastic moment in Australian sport. It had shades of that moment 16 years ago when John Aloisi scored that penalty to put the Aussies into our first FIFA World Cup since 1974.

Tuesday's result gave me some inspiration for this weekend's yarn. If the CDFNL went into a penalty goal shoot-out who would I selected to kick for us? There are a large amount of great goal kickers, but who would I *really* trust the most in front of the big sticks in a penalty shoot-out scenario?

1 - DOM DARE (Alvie)

First up, I'd choose Dom, he is one of the most reliable kicks for goal inside 50 in the comp. He rarely misses and that's why he has a huge lead in the CDFNL goal kicking ladder.

2 - NICK LYNCH (South Colac)

Another absolute dead-eye inside 50 for goal. I once even saw him trip himself up while going for goal, get up and still kick the major. So, composure under pressure, he ticks the box.

3 - NICK HARDING (Simpson)

Early days he was 50/50, but as he's matured he definitely now kicks more goals than behinds. It would take a very tough kick for him to miss.

4 - DAMIAN ZAPERENKOV (Apollo Bay)

A veteran forward, and at this point in time in the shoot-out, we need someone to take the lead. So, I need someone with a mature head and steady composure. Zaperenkov would kick it.

5 - CULLAN SPENCE (Alvie)

Cullan has a super boot kick, and if we've made it this far in the shoot-out we'd be aiming to definitely win it. Cullan is a ripper of a kick for goal.



6- DION LAWSON (Apollo Bay)

A bit of wild card entry, but at this point we are trying to win the shoot-out. Dion is an amazing kick for goal and I reckon he would have the composure and go back and kick it for the league.

7 - JIMMY ABRAHAM (Otway Districts)

If we had to go seven deep, Jimmy is my man. He is a fantastic kick for goal.

IN BEARD *we trust!*

Daniel Beard re-signed with Simpson last week, and we spoke to him about Simpson's impressive start to the season. Words **MAX BLAKE**.



MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us today Daniel. The Tigers are back on the winners last and in the five after Round 10. How have you rated your start to the year?

DANIEL BEARD: I believe we are about where I'd hope we would

be. I thought with the players who have come back to the club this year that it would take much for this group to be back in contention to play finals. We didn’t make any great predictions in pre-season, but the boys had a want to play finals, so we setup our pre-season to work towards being competitive.

We don’t however, base our success solely on our win-losses ratio. To me, it’s about the boys having fun, the culture of the group and building a positive voice in the community. If you ask me how I rate the season thus far, in those areas I’d say we have excelled. I could not be any prouder of this group.

MAX: Who have been some of the players that have impressed you this season?

DANIEL: I know its cliché, but I’m impressed with the whole group. Their buy-in from day

one has been superb and we’ve had wonderful attendance right through the pre-season. We are in a very fortunate situation that we have great numbers across both grades and the list is built entirely of locals who live within 20 minutes of the ground, running out each Saturday. We’ve given a lot of new players a go this year and it’s about the continual growth of the group, than it is about the individual.

MAX: What made you commit to continue coaching Simpson next season, so early into this one?

DANIEL: For two reasons. Firstly, I’m having a ball, and secondly, the growth in this group. These local lads are a super group of kids and are just so coachable. It’s just a really, really good place to be around and I’d like to keep building on that feeling around the club.

I grew up, down on Coorimungle Road and went to Simpson Primary and as a kid, ran around every weekend at Princetown. So, I know the area, know a lot of the families and there is a lot of those families still involved at Simpson. It’s really rewarding seeing the fun these kids are having with their football and how proud that’s making their parents.

MAX: I see you made a return to the footy field, on the weekend in the reserves and even snagged a goal. How did the body pull up?

DANIEL: Ha, ha, ha. I was fine. My brother had been at me for years to play a game at Simpson with him. So with having a home game for the weekend, the opportunity came up. We had seven of us on the Beard side of the family play together on the weekend and that was pretty special.

MAX: Can you believe it's coming up to 25 years since your big day out in the 1997 GF? 10 goals in a drought-breaking flag for Cobden. How many times have you watched the replay?

DANIEL: That was a special day for a lot of people. We've probably watched the 'highlights' version more than the entire game. It has the 'after' footage showing how much it meant to the supporters and the town. It was massive for Cobden. I'd love to be able to go back in time and re-live the atmosphere of those couple of weeks. We celebrated pretty hard!

MAX: In your time in local footy, who have been some of

greatest players you've seen? Played with or against?

DANIEL: We had some pretty handy players in that premierships year. I think we had five play for Vic Country from that one team! Shane Garner, Brett Taylor, Stephen Hammond, Sean Lever, Wayne Robertson, Wayne Walsh and Andrew Foster were all extremely good players. Some of the best players I've seen in country football would be Dan Nicholson, Joe Dare, Levi Dare, Shorty Anderson and Jason Mifsud.

MAX: So, Simpson are 6-4 after 10 Rounds. What's the focus for the second half of the season?

DANIEL: Our focus is to simply keep enjoying ourselves and continue our growth. That's everyone at the club - the players, the parents, the sponsors and the supporters. We work all week to make money and pay the bills and football has to be something we do for enjoyment. We have to provide an environment where our players want to come to train and play. The netballers are doing really well, our juniors are improving and our senior teams are both in the five at the minute. So, if we continue on as we have to this point, we are going to be in the mix and I'm really proud of the entire club for the positive vibe that we are spreading in the community. ■

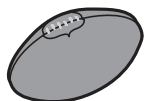

Bay's proud 50-year history

One of the inaugural clubs, Apollo Bay continues a proud tradition.

Apollo Bay originally played netball in the **Polwarth & District League** from 1952 to 1971 when **Margaret Dickason & Margaret Costin**, both now Apollo Bay Netball Life Members, established Netball teams in Apollo Bay. Originally it was known as Basketball. In 1971 Apollo Bay was one of the four clubs that held a meeting of all **Colac & District Football League** clubs to gauge the interest in forming a netball competition within this league. Following this meeting, netball became part of the Colac & District League.

In the inaugural 1972 Colac & District Football Netball season, our senior netball team won the netball grand final. Our team was **Jenny Riordan, Joy Telford, Lorraine Curry, Dot Beattie, Glenda Nosedo, Jan Whitney, Jenny Heinz and Wendy Varcoe**. Our senior netballers won the grand final again in 1972.

Apollo Bay Netball Club is one of only four clubs in the league that has proudly entered netball teams in each of the 50 years of competition from 1972 to 2022.

In the early years of the CDFNL, our netballers ran plenty of events to raise funds to go towards the construction of a netball court at the recreation reserve. Eventually, our first netball court was constructed near where the playground sits today.

In 2017, the netball and football clubs finally amalgamated to become Apollo Bay Football Netball Club. Our clubs were among the last few clubs in Victoria to amalgamate.

Our club has grown over the years, and we have continued to increase the number of teams we have been able to enter in the competition. Proudly, since 2004 when the C Grade competition was introduced, we have been able to enter six teams in the competition - U13, U15, U17, C, B & A Grade.

We have enjoyed premiership success over the 50 years. Our juniors have competed in and won grand finals in Under 14s 1985; Under 15s 1996; Under 16s in 1984 & 1987; Under 17s 2002. Our A Grade side has won in 1972 & 73 and were runners up to Alvie in 1984 & 1985. Our B Grade side won a hard fought premiership in 2010. **Katy Schrederis** won the trifecta that year - a premiership player, winning Best on Court in the grand final and then going on to win the B Grade League Best and Fairest.

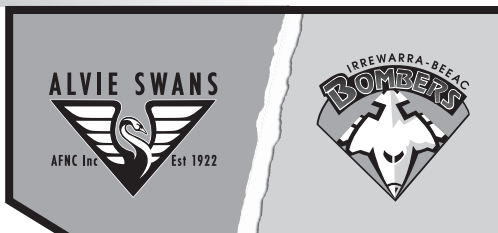
