


Interleague TIME!

Decorated netball star, **Rachel Rodger** has returned to the CDFNL this season, in what has been an impressive start. Ahead of the league's 50th year celebration, we spoke to her this week. Words **MAX BLAKE**.





"Not every league regards netball as highly as ours..."

MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us today Rachel. How have you found your return to the league so far?

RACHEL RODGER: I've loved getting back involved, the Bombers are a great club and being part of it again has been great. As for the league, I don't want to do the maths on the age gap with some opponents now. but it's great still seeing some familiar faces and coming up against some of my old rivals.

MAX: How have you found the standard of the league? Has it improved since you were last playing in the CDFNL?

RACHEL: It's hard to compare standards between the years, but

it's always been a strong comp for its size. The region has always been pretty fortunate to have a strong junior group that come through and make it what it is.

MAX: It's a big couple of weeks for the league, 50 years of CDFNL is a fantastic effort! I bet your mum is pumped?

RACHEL: It's great, we're so lucky we've got such a strong netball association within the footu/ netball league as a whole. And it's a credit to the likes of mum. and Val Russell, and Gwen Koop before them, who worked really hard to ensure our netball is as prominent as it is. Not everu league regards netball as highly as ours, so we're fortunate to

have had great women pushing the cause, and lots of us have benefited.

MAX: During your CDFNL career. who have been some of uour toughest opponents?

RACHEL: Certainly during most of my early and middle years it was Shaz Hickeu who I found toughest to play on. She was so talented, but such a clever player as well, I loved the challenge of taking her on. Then probably Kelly Pouw, now Thompson, I admire the way she plays the game and I really enjoyed our battles!

MAX: Who are some of the current plauers, teammates or opponents who've impressed you since you've returned?



RACHEL: There's a lot of new faces and names I don't know but from our matches so far I thought Janelle Monaghan was impressive. Against us Lorne were tough and had some strong new players. Our group is uouna (me aside). There's so much upside with the likes of Jeremi Robertson, Grace Garner and Rach Seabright. I'm eniouing seeing them improve.

MAX: You've been playing nethall for awhile now. What keeps you motivated to keep playing?

RACHEL: I started playing A Grade 27 uears ago, so awhile is putting it politely Max, thanks. It's really just the enjoyment of competing and being part of a team. It's what I've alwaus loved about sport, no matter what I'm playing. It's also as much about getting back to

spend time with mum, and familu and friends now That's what it's all about for me and the reason I came back to plau.

MAX: Do you have plans to step away from the game?

RACHEL: I don't really have a timeframe, it will all depend on what my body allows. When I don't think I'm keeping pace anymore, that would be a good sign to step away I think.

MAX: What has been some of your most memorable games you've played in?

RACHEL: All the grand final wins are the most memorable. As a club we were very fortunate and proud of what we achieved over a long period. But, our first few flags when I was 17 and 18 are probably still a standout, just because we were still the challengers




MAX: Irrewarra-Beeac are looking good this season. How far can the Bombers go? What will it take to win the flag?




