

# The Long sleeve of Winter is here! Kathmandu



MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us today, Jack. Eight games into your senior career at just 16. How do you feel you've gone so far?

**JACK SKINNER:** Yeah, I'm really enjoying the step up to senior footy. It's definitely a lot harder

then Under-18s, but I think I'm fitting into the team really well. I feel like I'm going ok, but I've still got a lot to learn. The team have been really supportive and helping me learn.

MAX: You're still able to play junior footy. What's made you commit to playing in the seniors this season?

JACK: I'd say, just being able to play better footy against the bigger bodies and better players. Also, I've already learnt so much more, playing at that level.

# MAX: What position do you like playing?

JACK: Definitely centre half forward. I love kicking a goal. but last week we changed it up a bit. I played centre half-back and I really enjoyed that too.

MAX: You played in the V/Line Cup earlier in the uear. You were named in the best and kicked a couple of goals. How was the experience playing in that game?

JACK: Yeah, that was really fun. I really enjoyed that experience and the footu was definitely a lot harder then local junior footy, and I made heaps of mates along the way.

MAX: Tell us about that big bomb goal you kicked at Birre earlier in the season. How far out were uou - 50. or 60 metres? It was a ripper.

JACK: Yeah, I was going to pass it off to a teammate, but a couple of the boys behind me just told me to back myself in and take my time. So, yeah it was something like 50-60 metres. I didn't take too much notice at the time.



#### MAX: Is it up there with one of the best goals you've kicked? Or have you kicked a better one?

JACK: Yeah, no definitely it's one of mu better goals. It's right up there with the goal I kicked against Alvie. Probably from the same distance and at the same crucial point in the game.

## MAX: Is there an AFL or local plauer(s) that uou've moulded your game around?

JACK: Not really, but I've been liking the way that Patrick Cripps (Carlton captain) has been plauing this year, so he's definitely someone I look up too.

### MAX: What's your pre-game routine. Fridau night through to Saturday morning?

JACK: Well, Fridau night I tru not to think about the game. Saturdau morning. Loet up. have a smoothie then head to the footu and support the Under-18s team, then put on some music in the ears. I then just start to focus on the game. Nothing too special.

### MAX: What's sort of pre-game music do you listen to?

JACK: A bit of everuthing. but probably my go-to song at the minute would be Snectrum (Say My Name), by Florence + The Machine.

#### MAX: How have you found coach (Paul) Liistro?







# Never the swansong

The strength of the Alvie netball club continues fiftu years on...

Ivie Football Club was one of the original clubs to enter the Colac & District Football League Netball Association when it formed in 1972. After much organisation from the newlu formed netball committee at the time, including Sue Hickey, Joan Parker and others, on Saturday 15th April 1972 teams from Alvie took the court for their first CDFLNA netball match. Since that dau Alvie, has been one of the only clubs in the league to field a side in every single year of the competition.

By the end of the 1978 season Alvie had taken home their first senior league best and fairest win by A Grade player Joanne Lunch, with Leanne O'Brien also taking league best and fairest honors for Alvie this year in the Under 16 division.

In the season of 1985, Alvie

had three grades entered in the competition - seniors, reserves and under-16's. Led bu coach Joan Parker the senior girls were hitting their straps with the likes of Rebecca Finn. Sharon Hickeu. Fiona Martin, Valerie Russell and Sue Hickey dominating across the court

The last three rounds of the Home and Away season were the finals weeks for netball at the time, with all finals played on Sundaus at the Eastern Reserve. Plauers from the time remember larger crowds at these games than they were used to, the Sunday timeslot meaning these were some of the only matches watched by local footballers, and recalling that "all the bous came to watch Bec!" (Rebecca Finn).

By the Sunday of Grand Final Dau in 1985. Alvie had fought through consecutive close

matches to make it there on the day, and the big dance would be no different, runnina into overtime before Alvie could finally come away with the win from Colac Imperials. The year was capped off bu Fiona Martin taking out senior league best & fairest honors following the Premiership win.

Consecutive senior premierships would follow for the club in 1986, 1987 and 1988. Club great Sharon Hickey won her first Senior Best & Fairest in the Premiership year of 1987 and again in 1989, followed by manu more throughout her netball career. Along with Rebecca Finn, their names flooded most best and fairest counts at the time.

Entering the 1990 netball season key players such as Julie Monaghan and Kerry Eldridge had joined the senior ranks and Alvie began another Premiership streak across the years 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993 and 1994.

lvie's most recent Premiership years have been in 2006 under coach Julie Monaghan and again in 2019, as the A Grade side emerged undefeated, premiers and champions under coach Morgan Eldridge. Key players in the 2019 Premiership team included Georgia Robinson, Chelsea Hillman, Laura Kelly, Lily Eldridge and Dallas Williamson - who is another Alvie great, highly decorated with Best and Fairest wins across her career.




