Saints smash Tigers run

Birregurra ended Simpson's massive 22-game winning streak in fine style. Simpson entered their Round 4 clash against Birregurra having won 22 games-in-a-row, including two flags - one against the Saints by a CDFNL Grand Final record margin, taking the league by storm.

Birregurra started the 2016 season on fire, winning their first three games of the season. This game had every bit of a blockbuster set to it - except it was the Saints who set the tone. Birregurra stormed out of the blocks, booting eight goals in the opening term and continued on their way to a massive 102-point smashing of Simpson - ending their huge run. ■

The HAIRCUT that became the talk of the World!

Back in 2011, a player was sent off for having a dangerous haircut.

It's 11 years on, but it's time to bring up this bizarre and insane story and relive this madness.

In May of the 2011 season, Simpson hosted Otway Districts. Young forward Nathan Van Someren was sent off in the third quarter by an umpire for having a dangerous haircut. The story went nationwide, then it became international news.

"Nathan Van Someren, who sports a towering gelled mowhawk, was told to leave the field in the third quarter of the Simpson Tigers match against Otway Districts when the ref took offence to his dangerous hair do". - Metro 50 UK.

Van Someren told the media at the time, "We all thought that he was taking the mickey out of me. A few umpires have made

jokes about my hair before, so I didn't think any more of it.

"Then I was just standing there and (the umpire) came across to me and goes, "I thought I told you, you couldn't come on the ground."

"I sort of just looked at him like "what?" and he's like, "no, I told you you couldn't come on the ground with that hairstyle, you have to go off."

Simpson would go on to win the match 11.22 (88) to Otway Districts 8.6 (54) and Nathan kept his mowhawk and played the following week, where he kicked a couple of goals.

He now walks around with a shaved head. But, in all my years of covering local footy this was the craziest thing that I have ever heard happen. ■

40 seasons of football and **Matt Zurbo** is still kicking goals. We spoke to him this week.

MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us Matt. I see you still running around dominating on the field - what keeps you motivated to keep playing?

MATT ZURBO: Yeah, season 40 of adult footy. I don't know about dominating. I'm just happy to have a dip each week. Earn my beer. Can't lose pace you never had! Love my Aussie Rules, is all.

MAX: You've played for a lot of teams on your journey. Where have been some of your favourite grounds that you've played on and why?

MATT: 680-odd games across four states. Footy's great like that. It's given me so much. I'm grateful.

The famous gravel oval in Queenstown was a privilege to play on, for sure! It's surrounded by snow-capped mountains, not one blade of grass! You had to roll when you fell.

Training in Townsville with the cane toads on the oval, and Port Douglas in the wet season with lightning and bats flying overhead was great, too.

St Helens involved a two to three hour drive through the rainforest. We'd always stay over, raise a little hell, surf off our hangovers. Ovals that were about the place, they were a part of.

There was one oval I regret not playing on. It was in the Outback. I saw it while working there for a bit. Just a fence around a patch of red desert - that was it. Playing a season there would have been epic.

Carlisle Oval was my favourite, though. It's a shame its not used anymore. It's so community based with the rolling hills. It always felt like coming home.

MAX: What about the players? Who have been some of the best players in your travels playing local footy?

MATT: Over four decades, I've made so many mates, who just happened to be great footballers. 'Feathers' was the best of both. Damian Dove, made anyone walk tall, both on or off the oval. Stewie Sutherland, Brad Maloney and so on.

The ones I admire the most are the ones who get every bit of football out of themselves. Players like Grant Budge. That's why Alex Burnett is my current best CDFNL player. There might be a few more who are better, but every week, every minute, he just gives his heart and soul. Every damn thing! None of us are AFL stars, so be a good bloke no matter how good or bad a footballer you are.

MAX: Now, you played in Otway



Districts last ever, senior grand final. It was back in the last ever season of the Heytesbury League - as the Kangaroos. Do you have many memories of that day?

MATT: Geez, you've got good memory! Frustration! Sam and Tom Harriott, Lenny Perkins and other club greats in their prime. We let the other mob (Heytesbury Demons) out of the gate and we couldn't reel them back in.

MAX: Did you get involved in that famous fight on the wing, that everyone in the crowd got into?

MATT: Yeah, I was there. It was a storm in a teacup. These things get bigger over time.

MAX: Do you remember much of that final season in the Heytesbury League? Do you remember it being a tough decision to head back to the Coliac District League?

MATT: No, for the players and club, it was inevitable. That league was an adventure, but we belong in the CDFNL.

MAX: Out of all the games you've played, has there been one that

sticks in the memory bank? Something odd that happened? A great game to be apart of?

MATT: So many! Coaching the Otway unders to a flag in 2000 was the absolute highlight, though. Khan Beckett, Dean Mahoney, Stewie Sutherland, Chris Shawcross and so on. Better than any game, or flag I won as a player, by a million miles. It was about the kids, the Otway people. To walk into the Cobden pub, with the cup and see every single person from the ranges, every family, kid and worker, was pure gold.

No matter when I'm in the country, I'll always comeback to Otway. You will never, ever get a more community-based, honest bush club. It's everything - really, family orientated.

Beyond that game, it's often the little stuff I remember. Like hot-wiring the Port Arthur oval lights. There were only two of them! Ha,ha! Training knee deep in mud, when I couldn't.

All the way to get to Dodges Ferry in time. The middle of winter, snowing, wallabies - great memories. Just me, and another worker - Aydan Marriner from the Bay, having a crack. I know I'm just a hack, but I've always tried to have a crack.

MAX: You're a writer, as well. I see you've written a book "Heart and Soul", plus you write articles for the *Footy Almanac*. What's behind the inspiration to write about footy?

MATT: I write about what you know. I love footy. I got offered to be sports writer for *The Age* a long time ago, but would've had to give up bush work and bush footy. It was a no brainer for me. Live life, and stories will follow. The stuff I write is about us, and ours.

MAX: You're a big footy fan. Who have been some of your favourites in the AFL?

MATT: I've always loved 'Pikey' (Martin Pike). Tough, underrated. Four times clubs wrote him off. Four flags later, he'd done the lot. I don't really follow anyone these days, but still like watching blokes I coached, like Nankervis, or former CDFNL players. It makes it personal, brings the AFL back to its roots.

MAX: Who's the next big superstar to come out of Otway? Is there another Dean Towers in the making?

MATT: Dean wasn't a superstar when he left, he was a slow burn. He played well at Otway, under the



great Tim Pekin. He played well at Colac, then at Ballarat. He just applied himself, kept improving and working. Learning! Every club has half a dozen with the potential to do that. Watch for Tein Britton in years to come. Sonny Lapene, they've got the right attitude. That's what counts.

Otway have a great list at the moment. Mostly young, early 20s, with heaps of room to grow as individuals and players. But, mostly, they are great people - all of them. That's the main thing. That's why blokes like Silk and the Bone brothers are so good - footy *and* character.

I'm just stoked to still be an active part of such a great club - in such a great league, in such a great part of the world. How lucky are we? Everyone of us! ■

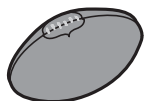
