





It's one of the great, long-lasting rivalries of the CDFNL. Today, the battle on the Great Ocean Road continues. Words MAX BLAKE.

he Coastal Cup - Lorne v Apollo Bay. It's the CDFNL's Carlton-Collingwood big rivalry - that no matter where the two sides sit on the ladder, it's a huge day and big contest.

Lorne have had the wood on Apollo Bay over the past two decades. But, for all their dominance in the Coastal Cup victories, amazingly the Dolphins have never defeated their arch rival in a senior CDFNL Grand Final. The two clubs have met in three CDFNL season deciders, with the Hawks winning all of them. The two teams in total have won 19 senior premierships, with Lorne 13 and Apollo Bay 6.

The two clubs combined have 17 league senior Best and Fairest winners, with the two winning the last four Mahoney Medals.

This weekend, the rivals will lock horns again at Stribling Reserve, but first, here's a look back at their head-to-head history.

JESSE: Yeah, I definitely think we can. We just have to be more consistent throughout our games. We're starting to find out what each other's abilities are and I think we'll be scaru, when we hit our strides.




