"SCOREBOARD!"

Ranking the CDFNL scoreboards around the league. Words MAX BLAKE.


he most important feature of anu footu club, is their scoreboard. It's a real showpiece of your club.

Throughout mu journeu, visiting local footu clubs. I've seen some absolute rippers and some really run down scoreboards. A few clubs are ahead of the game; with big LED screen scoreboards, featuring flashy lights. Others are traditional, prefering the old school stule. changing the scores by hand.

What makes a great scoreboard? Well, for starters, if uou can see it clearly from the other side of the ground, that ticks a lot of boxes. Easy to read, shows the full score, along with the goals and points is a bonus.

If a club can master the old school manual scoreboard, but add a splash of colour to it, combined with advertisements to help pau the bills - that's a win. I'm a local footy nuffie (but, you already knew that!) and love a good scoreboard.

So, here are my CDFNL scoreboards rankings - 1 to 10.



LORNE

I like to call it the "Kevin Murphy Scoreboard", because from the moment it was installed, he was bragging about it. It's an absolute ripper, even though it's a LED screen. It's BIG. easilu read and with the addition of club logos. There's space for other scores at the top, and you could probably see it from the moon! The old Dolphins scoreboard was also pretty good. We occupy it now for our broadcast games.

2 OTWAY DISTRICTS

The Demons' footu scoreboard is old school, manual-stule, Goals, behinds and points are indicated by G, B and P. The full score is displayed (which is a bit of a gamble, but they get it right!). It's a good balance of sponsors and scores, but when you look at it, it has an nice Otwau feel to it. It also indicates the length of the quarters.

3 WESTERN EAGLES

The Eagles' scoreboard is like pizza sometimes less is best. It still has a veru old school look to it. Wooden stule, which gives it charm, easy to read with no bright colours. It requires the locals at the ground to do a bit a arithmetic in their heads, to add up the total score.







4 APOLLO BAY

The Bau's new LED scoreboard is great. The height is perfect, full score - goals, behinds, points and a time clock. It's not as bright as Lorne's, but it's still a winner and a massive upgrade from their old one, which sits heside it



SOUTH COLAC

The Kangaroos' colour scheme is great and suits their club colours. You look at it and you instantly think of South Colac. The separation of the score to the background makes it easy to read, and again, challenges the locals to add up the score themselves. It could do with a time clock, though.



IRREWARRA-BEEAC

I respect the Bombers' stance on not upgrading this unique and very basic scoreboard. Normally, a glass background doesn't work, but because the whole thing is glass, it does. The positioning isn't great, but again, less is sometimes better and in this case it works



7 COLAC IMPERIALS

Too much happening on the Cats' scoreboard. Extra love for sponsors, but only about five per cent is given to the all important scores. It's prettu old and it maube heritage listed, but it's time for an upgrade to match in with those awesome modern lights.



ALVIE

The Swans were one of the first clubs from memory to ditch the old school scoreboard for the new electronic stule. But now it seems a little outdated compared to the newer ones. Still it holds up the red background suits the club colours. It's small, but and you can see it across the ground.



9 BIRREGURRA

The Saints' scoreboard is okau. it gives you what you need, if you can read it. It's a little too small to see across the ground, but it's a massive upgrade from their old manual one.



III SIMPSON

My eyesight gets seriously put to the test when heading out to Simpson. What doesn't help is the Tigers' oval is so big. that the distance from the wing to the grandstand side is larger than normal. But when the sun is shining on this scoreboard, it's virtually impossible to read. Sorry Tigers.



DELORENZO Beauty!

Alvie celebrate their 100th year as a club, this weekend and we spoke to one of their current superstars, **Andre Delorenzo** during the week. Words - MAX RLAKE



MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us today, Andre. The Swans are sitting on top the ladder and things are looking good. How have you rated the season so far?

ANDRE DELORENZO: It's been great to have an uninterrupted season so far. We're very happy with the wau we have started the season. still plentu to work on with some sides exposing areas we need to make adjustments in.

MAX: I know you'll want to keep a lid on it, but is this the best chance at winning a flag in your time at the club?

ANDRE: Certainlu. the first few years of seniors I thought we were a genuine contender, but Irrewarra-Beeac. Lorne and Birre were just a class above at the time. Since then, the last couple of years our depth has improved and we are playing patches of great footy.

MAX: Who have been some of the players at the club that have impressed you this season?

ANDRE: Matt Kelly and Lincoln's consistencu has been a huge asset, alongside Levi and Ben Lynch. But, I think the way Danny Allan has fitted back in has been a big key, with some of our outs from last season.

MAX: Both yourself and Lochie Rosevear are the generals down back. You guys seem to have



a really good relationship on field together?

ANDRE: I was able to learn a lot from Luke McCarthu in the earlu part of my career. The way Rosie had grown as a player and a leader has been a pleasure to watch. Getting to know him off the field keeps me a bit younger, too.

MAX: You've had a number of good coaches during your career at Alvie. How have you found Joe and what has he brought to the table differently, to others in the past?

ANDRE: I've been very lucky over mu time to have experienced so manu qualitu coaches. It's been great over the past years to have Joe impart his experience and shared leadership with this group. I've enjoyed his even approach with all our senior group, valuing each individual

MAX: Do you have any desire to coach senior footu one dau?

ANDRE: It's not something I've considered, but would be open to support where I can.

MAX: It's a big weekend for your club, celebrating their 100 years. What makes Alvie such a great club?

ANDRE: I think Alvie has a great mix of loyal families, with so many willing to put in the work behind the scenes, along with season to season getting some great new additions to the club which alwaus creates excitement, both on the football and netball side of the club

MAX: Which old legends produce the best stories from their past plauing daus?

ANDRE: Hard to split between Murrau Williamson, Dale Hunes or Barry Parker and Blonde Parker'. All four are very willing to explain to me that they never had hamstrings back in their day, along with plenty of game-day pointers!

MAX: Here is a big question! Who's been your toughest opponents in the league?

ANDRE: Hard to go past the ex-teammates - Christian and Coxy. Both have been very hard to get on top of. Recently, Damien Zaperenkov has also been challenging, with strength and pace. In the early part of mu career. Irrewarra-Beeac had diverse forwards like Elborough, Casey and Vickers which tested me early.

MAX: Has there been any standout games you've played that spring to mind? Maybe a final, or an epic home and away match, or even just a good win?

ANDRE: Thankfully, many! Early on, I remember some tight



MAX: We're about to enter the most exciting time of the season - finals. You've plaued in plenty. Do you still get pretty excited?

What do guys need to do, to bring home the ultimate prize?

I think we're tracking nicely, but the comp. is well positioned for a very tight finish and I think we just need to work on steeling ourselves when games get tight, and systematically working our way back from deficits.


