Roos end their prelim final hoodoo

Down by 40 points and with their backs to the wall, South Colac found away to earn a spot in the 2019 grand final.

Apollo Bay jumped South Colac in the opening 40 minutes of the 2019 Preliminary Final - kicking the first six goals, opening up a 40-point lead early in the second term.

The Roos had lost five of the last six preliminary finals coming into the game, but found a way to claw back into the match, trailing by only seven points at the final change. A six goal to two final term saw South Colac storm into the grand final. The celebration however, was short lived, with them losing heavily to Lorne the next week in the premiership decider. ■

There are many great movies, but as we enter the race for the premiership, here are the best sports movies I love to watch.

So, grab some popcorn, a Bulla Choc Top and this evening - choose one of my recommendations and your night will be set. ■

1 - THE MIGHTY DUCKS TRILOGY (1992-96)

Duration: 3+ hours.

These movies are my go to when I'm having a sick day. *Champions*, *D2: The Mighty Ducks*, and *D3: The Mighty Ducks* are absolute classics. Maybe the next Western Eagles coach could be Gordan Bombay?

It's a story of a struggling junior hockey side and by movie two, they are world champions. A stack of 90s nostalgia.

2 - REMEMBER THE TITANS (2000)

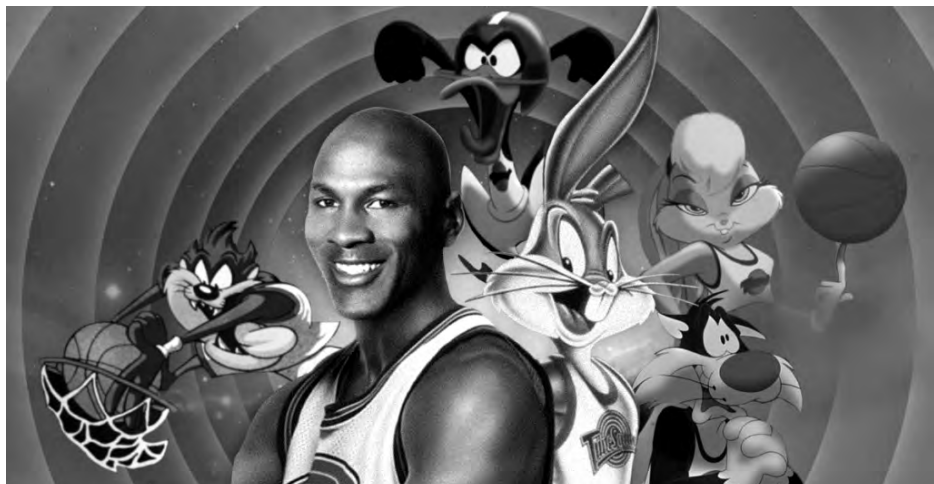
Duration: 1hr, 53mins.

One of the greatest movie of all time, let alone sports movie. Denzel Washington is in his elite acting era. The sport action in this is fantastic, but the story is incredible.

3 - HAPPY GILMORE (1996)

Duration: 92mins.

One of the greatest sports movie rivalries of all time. Happy Gilmore v Shooter McGavin. It's funny and makes you want to go to your nearest golf driving range to a whack a few balls.

4 - THE MERGER (2018)

Duration: 103mins.

An Australian drama comedy film. A local footy nuffy gold mine, here. But, it also might just hit a few spots. A struggling local footy club on the verge of merging, takes on the town's immigrates and turns the club's fortunes around. Damian Callinan is just brilliant amongst a great cast. It also has some of the greatest local footy lingo quotes in it.

5 - SPACE JAM (1996)

Duration: 88mins.

Warner Bros. took a real life story, (Michael Jordan retiring and returning) and placed a Looney Tunes story and made it a work of art. It has one of the best movie soundtracks, a long list of cameos and a huge dose of 90s nostalgia written all over it.

It's a shame that the sequel, *Space Jam: A New Legacy* they made starring LeBron James, was an absolute shambles.

6 - ROCKY I-IV (1976-1985)

Duration: Take the day off work!

If you have the spare time, binge all four *Rocky* movies - *Rocky*, *Rocky II*, *Rocky III* and *Rocky IV* (but don't bother with *Rocky V*). Followed it up with the *Creed* trilogy. They are brilliant. My favorite is Rocky taking on Mr T.

7 - COOL RUNNINGS (1993)

Duration: 98mins.

It's a sport you'd never watch (Bobsledding), but this is a great out the box story. John Candy was a great actor back in the 80s and 90s. This was his second greatest movie, behind *Uncle Buck*, which his finest masterpiece.

8 - INVICTUS (2009)

Duration: 133mins.

The story about the South African rugby team winning the World Cup, in a time when their country was divided by apartheid. It was really

good with some great action and brilliant acting from Morgan Freeman as Nelson Mandela, and Matt Damon as Francois Pienaar, the Springboks' captain.

9 - THE LONGEST YARD

(ADAM SANDLER VERSION - 2005)

Duration: 113mins.

Prison guards taking on criminals in a game of American football. What more can you ask for? There's also a soccer UK version of this movie, *Mean Machine* starring Vinnie Jones. Maybe a director could make an AFL version?

10 - MYSTERY, ALASKA

(1999)

Duration: 119mins.

A local ice hockey team who dominates their regional competition gets to host a NHL team in a practice match. Starring Russell Crowe, this movie is seriously underrated. Maybe this year's CDFNL premier could host an AFL side next year?

James Beasley plays senior game 150, this weekend for the Western Eagles, we caught up with him this week. Words - **MAX BLAKE**.

MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us today, James. Game number 150 this weekend! Has reaching the milestone come around quick?

JAMES BEASLEY: Yeah, it has some what. I missed a few games this year with Covid and a suspension, but very rarely do I miss a game.

MAX: What's been some of the highlights in those 149 games?

JAMES: Probably the people I've got to play with along the way. Whether it's the older fellas you look up to, or the younger ones coming up, and seeing their individual improvements is great to see. The wins are obviously great, and how much they mean to our club and supporters.

MAX: Who are some of your favourite teammates you've played with?

JAMES: 'Hards' (Craig Hardingham) is an obvious one, and I won't be the last to tell you the impact he's had on the club. Eamon Johnson was huge for me, playing my first few years of senior footy. 'KT's (Kallan Thompson) stepped into his captaincy role really well, and constantly surprises me with efforts on the field, and off the field he goes to a whole another level. A whole host of other players come and go for different reasons, and I got to play with both my brothers for a game this year, as well. So, the list isn't all that small.

MAX: What about opponents? Who have been some of the hardest you've played against? Who are the ones you've enjoyed playing against?

JAMES: 'Jezza' (Jeremy) Spokes. He's fit and quick enough to make

life very difficult and gets forward to kick goals. On top of that he's a great fella, so I can't get physical with him to slow him down, not that'd it faze him, I'd imagine. Same can be said about Alex Burnett. I've seen him kick checksides, from 40 metres in front and he's and good decision maker on both feet.

Colac's such a small place, it's usually a love-hate on the day, but most of time I'm quick to grab a beer for anyone I've had a run in with during the day. I love playing against Paddy Ryan, and he's definitely copped a few cheeky jabs from me in a couple of games with a smile.

MAX: What's kept you at the Western Eagles?

JAMES: There's no place like home. Like I said earlier, the people around the club are great. Whenever we get a win, the rooms

JAMES: Jack Fish and Tully Borgia haven't played senior footy, yet. But they're incredibly hard working, genuine stars in their age groups. Connor Carson is already playing well, when he comes up. 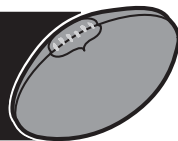

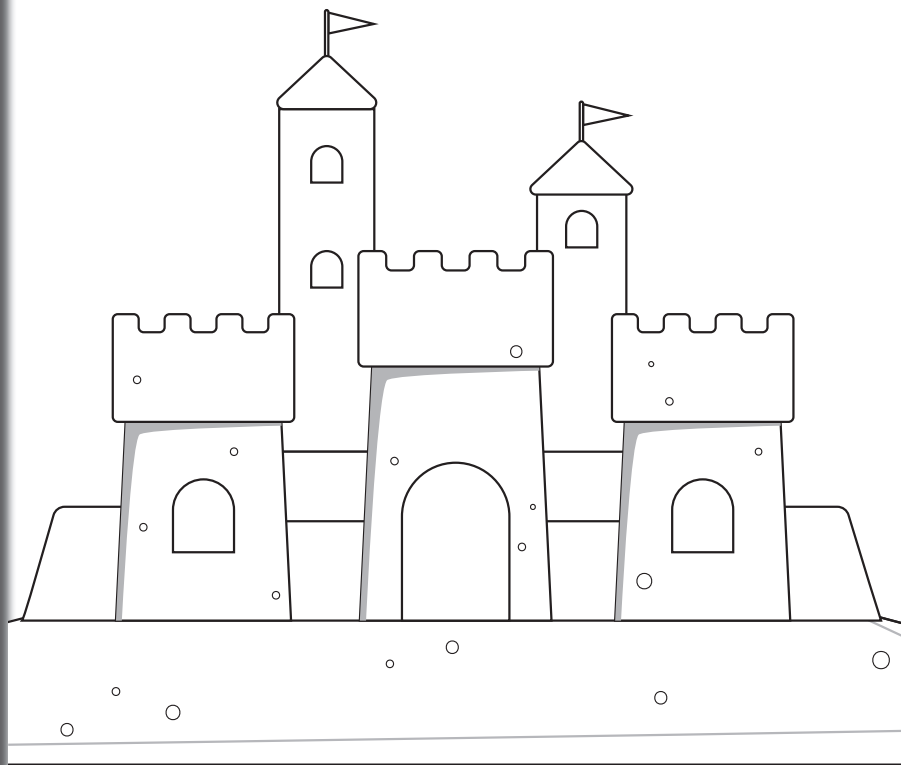

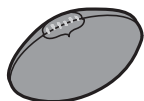

Short, but rich history

Every Demon heart beats true for the red and blue.

In 2007, I joined Otway Districts with no idea what a football/netball Club was about. With half done club rooms, old school bar, no carpet and some chairs around the fire inside.

At the netball courts, there were lumps and bumps throughout and the change rooms were dark and featured second hand furniture that was at least 50 years old, you know those ones you sink in and are actually really comfortable!

I'm not sure on the reason why we played there, but I remember playing my first game at **Carlisle River ground**, which was one of the clubs absorbed by **Otway Rovers** in 1974 then they merged with **Gellibrand** to create Otway Districts. These netball courts are still there today, and even with the tree roots growing under and through them. **The Carlisle River Cricket Club** has made a temporary cricket pitch for their women's team to train on!

Although I haven't been around the club since the beginning, it was exciting to speak to so many men and women who knew so much about the club and where it all began.

Whilst we still haven't pieced together all our netball history, we have loved having our secretary, **Linda Perkins**, who is also one of our famous grand final players from the 1996 A Grade premiership team who started a brief overview for us.

OTWAY DISTRICTS - NETBALL HISTORY

1982 - Otway Districts commenced playing in the Colac & Districts Football Netball League. They played from 1982-1993 in the Colac & Districts League, before going into recess in 1994.

1994 - Otway Districts went in to recess, with no footy or netball played.

1995-2002 - Otway Districts competed in the **Heytesbury Mt Noorat League** and during that time, the Demons won the 1996 A Grade netball premiership against **Kolora**, defeating them by one goal. The premiership side - **Helen Evans, Amanda Trotter, Linda Hill, Monica Evans, Brenda Perkins, Nicole Mahoney, Debbie McCarthy, Heather Sandercocock and Linda Perkins**. Coached by **Kath Lowen**.

2014 - C grade won the grand final defeating **Simpson** by one goal. In the same year, our Under-15s side made the grand final, but unfortunately lost to **South Colac** by one goal.

2016 - C grade lost to **South Colac** in the grand final by six goals.

2017 - Under-15s were defeated by one goal in the grand final against **Colac Imperials**.

2019 - Under-17s and A grade were the last sides to make a finals appearance. A grade lost to **Alvie** 51 to 32 and our 17 &



Under side lost by 10 goals to **Irrewarra-Beeac**.

2003 was the year Otway Districts returned to the **CDFLNA**, and unfortunately this is as far back as we can access for any netball records and the number of games played by each player. We are hopeful by the end of the season to be able to recognise all past and present players who have featured at the netball club for a significant amount of games and those still playing.
