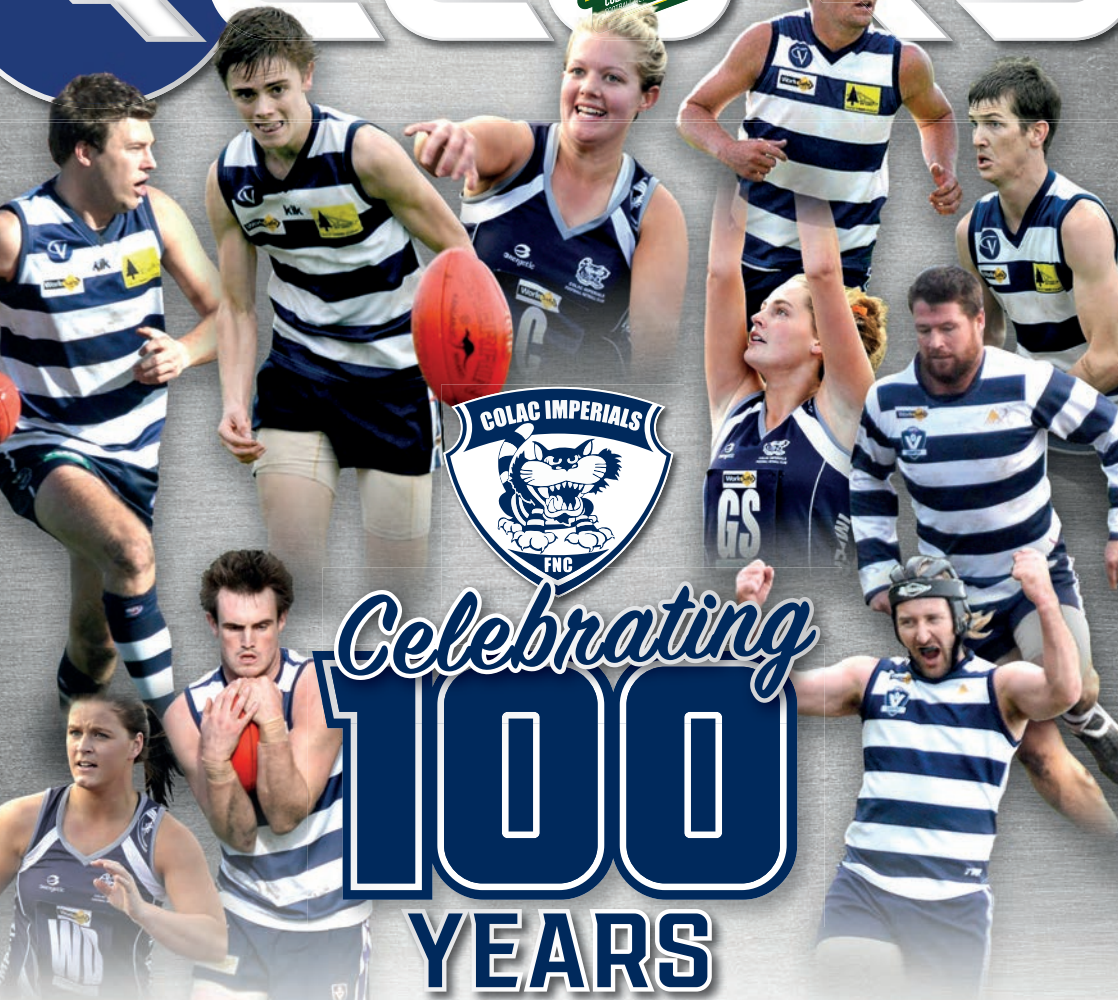

Reserve WARRIORS

The best 10 of the decade from the 12 O'Clock show. Words **MAX BLAKE**.

So much hype and talk surrounds our senior football and A grade netball codes. While the ultimate at every club is win a senior football or an A Grade netball flag. The blokes who represent the 12 O'Clock show are a virtual part of every teams success. Whether it's contributing to the sides' young players and helping them develop, or increasing the club's bar sales after 2pm by cheering on the senior sides.

They're a underrated part of local footy. So today, I'm rating the top 10 best reserves players of the past decade in the CDFNL. However, there's a certain criteria to meet. Selection was done on the basis of the number of reserves games play and the very few senior games played. I've allowed for 10.

The criteria is based on their status in the reserves grade, contributions to the bar sales post 2pm and ability to not do a pre-season, but preform from the get-go in Round 1. ■

1 - JASON KORDUPEL

(Simpson, Otway Districts & Simpson)

Jason's been the reserves best ruckman/big man for well over a decade, and he's still going. He's played in flags and coached sides and at times took the midday madness game a bit too serious. Frequent sprays to his players, that you could hear from Gellibrand to Hobart. He used his size and strength to perfection, considering he was not the fastest man alive - quite the opposite in fact. He'd perform his duties between 12-2pm and then lend support to the senior sides and his club's takings for the day.

2 - PAUL DOERY

(Irrewarra-Beeac & Western Eagles)

Paul is the CDFNL voice of reserves football. He created a campaign that the grade needed an interleague team. He produced his team of the decade (which has helped my top ten article, today). He's the glue to the Western Eagles backline. Paul did play a handful of senior footy in 2015, but he's been an absolute

iconic reserves footballer over his playing journey. A statue of Paul will need to be made halfway between Beeac and Irrewillipe, when the great man finally decides his kicking the dew off the grass, days are over.

3 - TYSON ARNOLD (Simpson)

In the words of Western Eagle, Paul Dorey "Tyson is twos' football personified." An amazing achievement to play well over 100 games with only a handful of senior footy games. What was Adam Courtney thinking? Tyson is hard as a cat's head and goes absolute bonkers from midday on a footy field, and then follows it up well after two in the outer.

4 - BEN RHODES

(Forrest, Colac Imperials, South Colac & Irrewarra-Beeac)

Ben played well over 100 games in his 'ressie' career, across four great clubs. Not a bad effort for a ripper reserves warrior. Apparently, not my words - but his mouth runs faster

than his legs... he's the ultimate reserves utility.

5 - ALEX HEATON-HARRIS

(Irrewarra-Beeac, Apollo Bay, Irrewarra-Beeac, Apollo Bay, Irrewarra Beeac)

Strong and solid, Alex had the ultimate physique for the style of footy that's played at 12 noon. His career consisted of a yo-yo, switching back and forth from the 'Bay to Bomberland, but when he played, he gave his absolute all.

6 - SHANE BARBER

(Colac Imperials & Apollo Bay)

Reserves footy isn't all about ability. It's about persistence, the willingness to take hits and get back up again. No judgement of dropping easy chest marks, just having a crack and doing your best you can do. 'Chicky' is that bloke - an absolute footy legend in Colac, as a great clubman. He's still having a crack now... and still dropping chest marks. His footy IQ is off the charts. Imagine if it could match his ability?

7 - BRIAN FARNES

(Otway Districts)

Age is just like wine in 'Ressies' footy. It doesn't see a number, it sees an absolute legend having a decent crack. Brian gets a fair bit of traction on the 'Ultimate Ressies' Insta account, so I needed to have him in the list. A skinny 'Santa Claus' looking bloke, running around in your league's two's comp. just gives him an automatic nomination for a top 10 spot.

8 - RYAN FENNELL

(South Colac)

A former South Colac club president, who wears a helmet has to be added to any reserves top 10 list. While leading the Roos off-field, Ryan was working his magic on-field during the 12 O'Clock show. He was one of a very small handful of two's ruckman that could actually leap off the ground. Some might say that should disqualify him from the list, but not in my books!

9 - JAMES FLEMING

(Alvie)

Alvie's favourite non-senior 12 O'Clock hero! If I start talking Alvie reserves



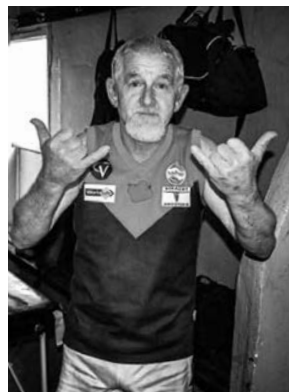

10 - DANIEL KETTLE

(Lorne)

The long sleeve warrior from the Pod just had to make the list. We've had big guys, helmet wearers, club presidents and old farts, so we just had to have a traditional long sleeve jumper wearer in the list.

MAX: Talk goal kicking with us. You've kick a lot during your career. How long did it take for you find the perfect way to do a

set shot, or is it something you continue to work on?

NICK: Yeah, it's taken a long time, mate. I'm still trying to improve even today on my goal kicking. It's important as a forward to impact the scoreboard as much as you can these days, with just how even the comp. is.

MAX: What do you do when you spray the first couple of shots during a game?

NICK: I like to stay up beat, it's not like cricket, where you only get one chance. With footy you have 120 minutes to have an impact. That might only be 10 minutes of that game.

MAX: Which teammate do you think has delivered you the ball the most, inside 50?

NICK: It hurts me to say it, but Brad Salmon.

MAX: What advice would you give to any young full forward, coming through the ranks?

NICK: Do plenty of goal kicking practice - before and after training and just enjoy playing footy with your mates.

MAX: How many more seasons do you have left in you?

NICK: At this stage, mate this will most likely be my last. So, hopefully, we can keep winning to keep me on the ground.

MAX: So, this Saturday could potentially be your last game! Why are you hanging up the boots?

NICK: Yeah, it could be, mate! I really want to focus on my business. I'm 30 next Saturday and the body lets me know my age every Sunday.

MAX: What's your favourite opposition ground to play on and why?

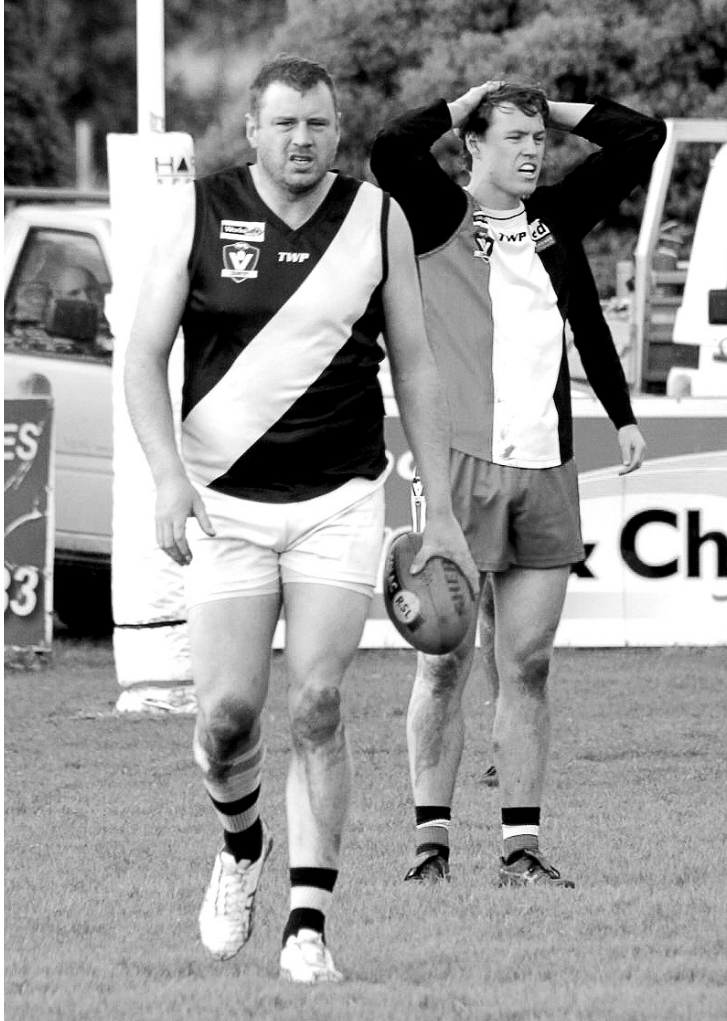
NICK: This one is out there, but I like Otway's ground. Why? Because, I always seem to kick a bag down there.

MAX: Who's been some of the best players you've played with and seen in the league?

NICK: The best players I've played with? The two come to mind

NICK: I'm going to say 2015, because we got to celebrate with the heart and soul of the group - Jayden McVilly, because he was in hospital in 2014 with a broken arm.

MAX: What makes the Simpson footy club so great?

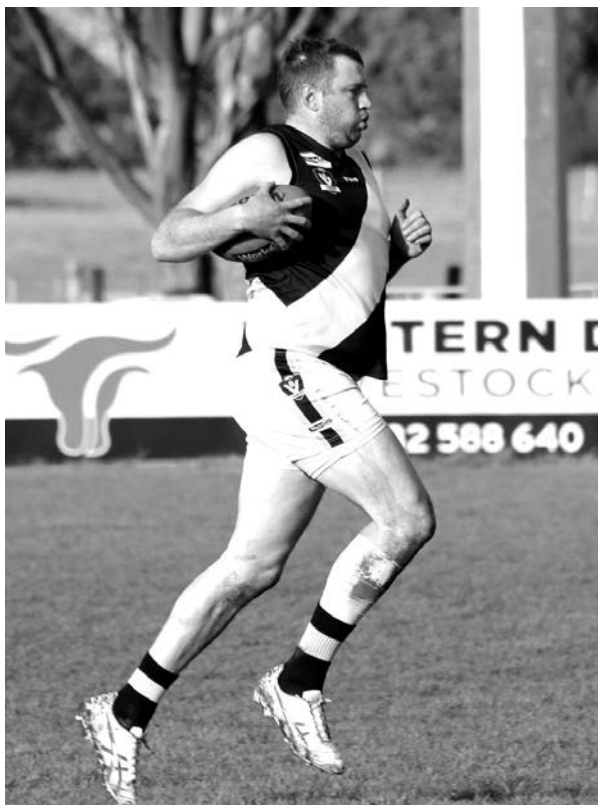
NICK: It's just a fantastic club. It's not a divided club, it's not football v netball. We're just one. It's one for all, and all for one. It's a great family club.

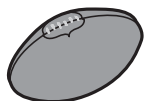
