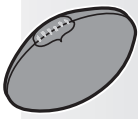

The *Eliminators*

It's been done before, but can the Colac Imperials do it again?

Here's a look back at sides of the past that have claimed premierships from elimination finals territory. Words **MAX BLAKE**.

The Colac Imperials have won their way through to the second week of the CDFNL 2022 Finals Series, after facing elimination from 20 points down last Sunday against Simpson, to claim victory by 21 points. But, the Imps' mission for this year's flag shouldn't just stop this weekend. Over the past decade, we've seen a few sides make it to week three and even go all the way to the big dance. ■

SOUTH COLAC - 2013

If you thought last weekend's AFL season had a dramatic end, spare a thought for South Colac in 2013.

The Roos only needed to win their Round 18 game against the Hawks to make the five. They failed and 10th-placed Irrewarra-Beeac rolled Birregurra (who also just had to win to make the five). This allowed South Colac to make the finals, finishing fifth.

The following week South Colac knocked off the Western Eagles in the elimination final. They then defeated Apollo Bay in the first semi-final, only to lose to the Colac Imperials in the preliminary final.



IRREWARRA-BEEAC - 2015

In 2015, Irrewarra-Beeac returned to the finals, after failing several attempts since their 2010 triple premiership win. The Bombers faced the Saints in week one, in an elimination final and came from 24 points down to roll Birregurra in a thriller. They followed up with an upset win against Colac Imperials in the first semi final.

In week three, Irrewarra-Beeac defeated South Colac in the preliminary final, in what was the surprise result of the season, reaching the Grand Final.

In the Grand Final, the Bombers were only three points down at the final change, but the Tigers, who were a class above the competition that season stormed home to victory.

SIMPSON - 2016

In 2015, in week one of the finals series, Simpson came from behind to defeat the Colac Imperials in a wet elimination final. The Tigers then followed up with a thrilling classic win over the Dolphins in the first semi-final. This game was later described by many as one of the finals of the decade.

Unfortunately for Simpson, they rang out of gas in the preliminary final, with South Colac defeating them and advancing to the Grand Final.

APOLLO BAY - 2019

The Hawks had an amazing final series in 2019. They smashed Alvie in the elimination final, booting the decade's highest final score. Apollo Bay, then in week two, followed up their victory with a extra time win over Birregurra.

In the preliminary final, the Hawks were 40 points up in the second term against the Roos, but South Colac came from behind to defeat them in the final term to make the Grand Final.

BILLY: I don't mind traveling

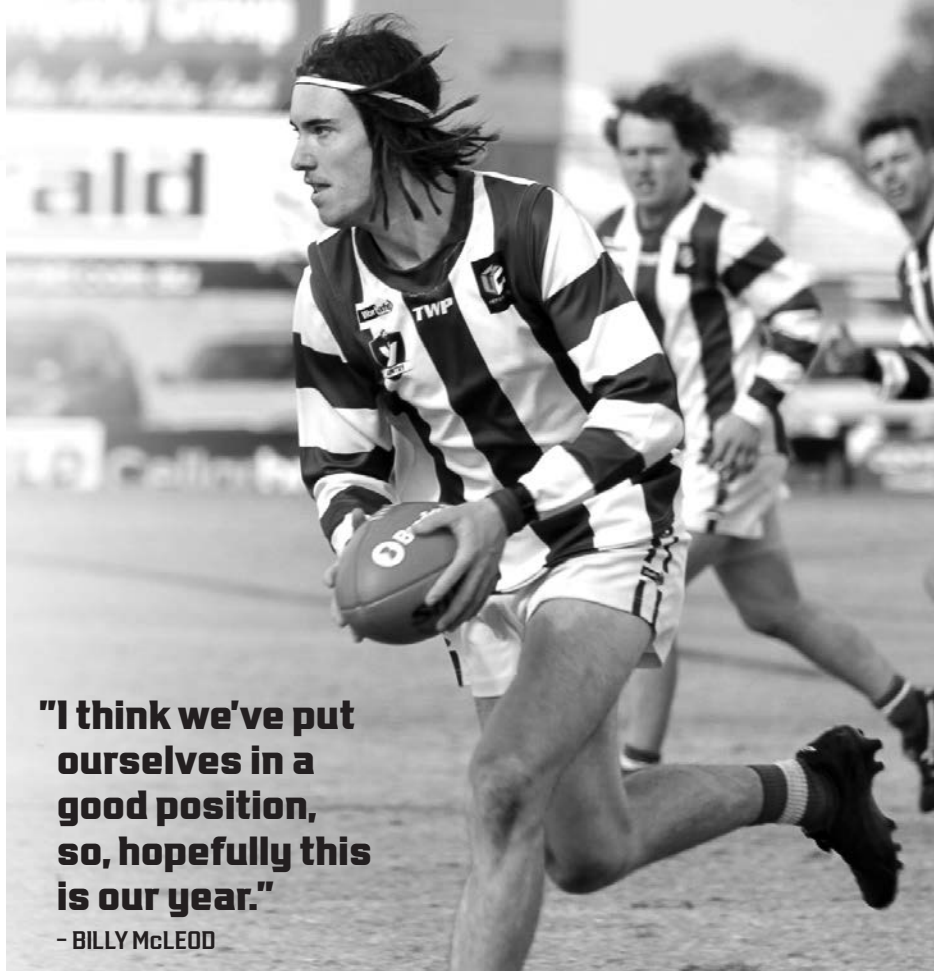
to Lorne. It's always a nice surface to play on and the new renovations look great!

IMPS END FINALS DROUGHT

Colac Imperials had to come from behind to end their senior finals drought in a thrilling elimination final against Simpson last Sunday.

The **Imps** entered the clash without finals win, since 2013 and found themselves 20 points down in the second term. But from then on, they clicked into gear, dominating across the ground to win **12.4 (76) to 7.13 (55)**.

The third term brought plenty of carnage to both teams, with the Colac Imperials losing key midfielder, **Campbell Scott** to an ankle injury and Simpson lost key forward, **Nick Harding** to a knee injury.

Dwayne Henke kicked four goals, while **Luke O'Shannassy**, **Sam Lucas** and **Jack Skinner** were named in the best players for the winners.

Nick Harding, **Jason McVilly** and **Brad Salmon** kicked two goals each for Simpson, while **Rhys Jansen Van Beek**, **Braden Poole** and **Brad Salmon** were named in the **Tigers** best.



ROOS PREVAIL IN QUALIFYING FINAL

It wasn't pretty, but **South Colac** earned their second semi-final spot this weekend against **Alvie**, with a hard-fought victory over **Irrewarra-Beeac** in last week's qualifying final.

It was the **Bombers'** first loss since Round 2 this year. They were dealt a cruel blow prior to the match, with player-coach **Cam Parker**, withdrawing from the match, due to health and safety protocols.

The qualifying final didn't reach any great heights, with the **Kangaroos** booting three goals, one behind in the opening term and pretty much held onto that lead all afternoon, recording a **6.9 (45) to 3.2 (20)** victory.

South Colac's **Seb Hay** was the only multiple goalkicker, booting two goals. **Billy McLeod**, **Brendan Monaghan** and **Tom McKean** were named in the **Kangaroos'** best, meanwhile **Rhyley Walker**, **Mitch Gaunt** and **Jackson Richardson** were named in the **Bombers'** best.
