

D ROUND 3 – EASTER SATURDAY

We spoke to Irrewarra-Beeac star goal shooter, **Courtney Garner** before this weekend's preliminary final. Words - MAX BLAKE.

MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us today Courtney. It's been a big season at Bomberland. The girls are into a Preliminary final. How have you rated your season so far?

COURTNEY GARNER: Thanks for having me Max!

We're very excited to be here in the Prelim. I think the results of the finals series so far, show just how close the A Grade competition is this year. There hasn't been any easy games!

We're a very tight knit group, and I honestly feel so lucky I get to spend my Saturdays with these girls. We've worked really hard over the past few years to get to where we are now and we just hope we have what it takes to go all the way this season!

COURTNEY: To be honest, I've probably practiced more this season than ever before. But I've possibly had my most inaccurate season, yet so I'm not sure if I should be throwing around tips on that! I've never really had any set routine, but I always make sure I get to training at least half an hour early to put some shots up and if I've got a spare hour here or there throughout the week, I'll get out and practice.

MAX: Who's been your toughest opponent in your career?

COURTNEY: I'd have to say Edwina Parker. She's just a really clean defender, who reads the play beautifully and makes her goalies work hard for every delivery. Her vertical leap is also very impressive!

MAX: What's one of your all time favourite games you've played in or been apart of?

COURTNEY: Hopefully, my response to this question might be different in a couple of weeks time! But, taking the court with Rach Rodger for her 300th

Seven days in football

South Colac advanced to the grand final, while Irrewarra-Beeac ended the Colac Imperials' finals dream.

SOUTH WIN IN AN EPIC

South Colac won its first, second semi-final since 2011 with a thrilling two-point win over Alvie.

This final had everything! A high scoring first half with some great goals and big marks. The second half saw spot fires everywhere. A huge hanger on the wing from Matt Kelly and a grind to the finish. In the end, the Kangaroos made the most of their opportunities in front of goal. The Swans however, missed a few easy ones in the final moments, opening the door for the Roos to record a 10.9 (69) to 9.13 (67) win.

Ben Cox, Nick Lynch and Jordan Foley all kicked two goals. Sam Giblett, Brendan Monaghan and Mitch Perkins were named in South Colac's best players.

Harry Carmody and Cullan Spence kicked three goals each for the Swans, while Matt Kelly, Lincoln Dare and Levi Dare were named best on ground.

'WARRA BURST IMPS' BUBBLE

Irrewarra-Beeac stormed back onto the winner's list and kept their premiership quest alive, while ending the Colac Imperials season. The Bombers recorded a huge 51-point victory in the first semi-final.

After a low scoring first term, the Bombers booted five goals to none in the second term, holding onto a huge 40-point lead at half-time.

The Imps put the Bombers under pressure in the third, but it wasn't enough as Irrewarra-Beeac recorded a **10.18 (78)** to **3.9 (27)** win and advanced to the preliminary final.

Mitchell McGlade and Tom Jackson kicked two goals each for the winners, with Tom Ennor, Mitch Thornton and Tom Jackson named in their best players.

Dwayne Henke, Campbell Scott and Luke Garner kicked the Imps' goals, with **Thomas Cahill**, Jack Skinner and Steven Cass named in their best players.

Huge upset in the prelim final

Having lost just the one game during the home and away season, South Colac were raging favourites for the premiership coming into the 2015 finals series.

South Colac entered the 2015 finals series with just the one defeat of the season. They lost the second semi-final to Simpson by four goals and came into their preliminary final overwhelming favourites against Irrewarra-Beeac, who entered the game via all the elimination final stages.

The Roos started strongly, taking a 10-point lead at the first change and looked in total control. But, scores were locked at half-time and again at three-quarter-time. It took some Khan Beckett brilliance, as the Bombers produced one of their best final terms since their 2010 flag. Irrewarra-Beeac kicked six goals to three, winning 11.13 (79) to 9.9 (63) and booking themselves a spot in the 2015 Grand Final against Simpson.
