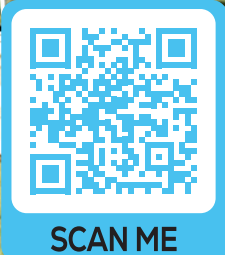

2024 SEASON PREVIEW

ALVIE the benchmark... *again!*

Alvie will again be the benchmark going into the 2024 season, but there's a number of sides nipping at their heels. Here's my season preview. Words **MAX BLAKE**.

Alvie broke their 23-year premiership drought last year and are showing no signs of slowing down. In fact, judging by their first two games of the season they've gone to another level!

The Swans go into Round 1 today, clear premiership favourites - adding some key recruits such as **Jay Moody** (small forward), **Chris Moreland** (midfield-forward) and **Will Paulin** (midfield). All possessing a high-level of experience, but it's their ball movement that has been impressive so far. The Swans side seems in complete sync with each other and they're going to be hard to beat this season.

Last year's runners up, the **Colac Imperials** have been hit hard in their backline during the off-season. Key defender, **Sam Lucas** has departed to **Cobden** in the Hampden League, while **Tom Cahill** has left to work interstate. **Jack Skinner** was recruited to the **Geelong Falcons** and **Darcy Theodore** is taking some time out to spend more time with family.

However, the Cats welcome in **Indy Parish** (midfield), **Lochie Donne** (ruck/defender) and **Tom Simpkin** (defender), which will help their stocks around the ground. Last week wasn't pretty, but coach **Paul Liistro** is a mastermind in the coaches box and no doubt he'll draw upon his experience to help the Imps push for the premiership.

We welcome former **Carlton great, Ed Curnow** to the CDFNL, as he takes on the role as player-coach of **Lorne**, who is a side right back into premiership contention.

I'm really looking forward to seeing how Ed plays in our league this year, but also to see his recruits he's landed.

In the off-season he's brought in his brother, **George** (midfielder), **Charlie McCartin** (forward) - brother of **Sydney Swans' Tom and Paddy, Bryce Vincent** (midfielder) and **Jackson Bright** (forward/midfield). They ooze talent and if it all clicks, watch out!

Simpson and **South Colac** will not only be aiming to return to the top five, but to challenge for the this year's title. The **Tigers** missed the finals last year after an promising 2022 season and have recruited strongly during the off-season.

Headlining their recruits is former **Melbourne** and **Essendon AFL ruckman, Mark Jamar**, former **Richmond AFL player, Aadam Maric** (midfielder) and **GFL star forward, Jarrd Garth**, along with a host of others. They've been impressive so far in their practice matches and will definitely be a side to watch this year.

Meanwhile, **South Colac** welcome **Brad Surkit** as coach, who is also a jet in the midfield. Also joining the Roos this year is key forward, **Jordan Erskine** who will give Alvie's **Dom Dare** a run for his money in the the goal kicking race. The Kangaroos dropped out of the finals last year, after winning the 2022 premiership. They'll be keen to jump back into the top 5. **Irrewarra-Beeac** and **Birregurra** who both had impressive seasons last year, will again be aiming to

continue their run up the ladder. Both sides still lack a big key forward who can break open a game, like the sides above them can.

The Bombers welcome in **Dom Slater**, who showed on Opening Day he could be *that* player and more time playing for Irrewarra-Beeac might just see that happen.

The wildcard of the season has to be **Otway Districts**. Former **Lorne** champion, **Allan Alford** has taken over the side as coach and has them looking sharp heading into the new season. The Dees were impressive at stages last season, causing upsets against the Dolphins and Roos. Finals should be on their radar this season.

Could **Dan Casey** be the *Ted Lasso* of the CDFNL? We welcome back Dan to the league, as he takes on the big role of coaching the **Western Eagles**. While he welcomes in a host of good recruits, which will improve the Eagles, the sides around

them have also improved their lists.

Apollo Bay, again have gone down the local youth path. I hope we see them be more competitive in games this season. They do have some exciting talent coming through, and will be a team not to take lightly this year. ■

PETER: I personally don't like it. It takes away traditional rivals and it creates division within those clubs and leagues.

MAX: If you could get one club from any other league to come into the CDFNL, who would it be and why?

PETER: Winchelsea - as they had a great rivalry within the CDFNL last time they were in. It would

also help them recruit good players. I think they have only played finals a couple of times since leaving.

MAX: We're starting to see more and more night games in the league. Could we potentially see a night final?

PETER: Potentially, a twilight final. Not sure about night though, as spectators struggle to see the game, including myself.

MAX: Tell us your Top 5 canteens of the league?

PETER: Otway is best by a long way! But, I'm bias. Alvie Simpson Irrewarra-Beeac Colac Imperials

But, really they are all good and the volunteers that work in them do a great job! The work they do, is really what makes country sport all about.

MAX: What are your thoughts on senior interleague? Do you think we could see it make a return in the future?

PETER: If players that are picked by selectors are committed, yes! But, cost is big if they don't. No good travelling miles, if you don't take your best side.

MAX: Umpire numbers seem to decrease every season. What are some ways you think we could pump up the numbers and get people into umpiring?

PETER: That's very interesting, as everyone has ideas. We have tried year, after year to pump them up. We need to encourage younger people to take it up. We need to make it enjoyable to do it, with players playing their part by engaging with the umpires.

MAX: I know your passion is junior sport. It seemed like a few years ago junior footy in the area was getting a bit light on. But, now it seems to be



steadily coming back, with all 10 sides fielding teams in U18 and U14.5 grades. Is it still a worry? How can we get more kids on the footy fields?

PETER: Like anything we do, you take your eye of it and it falls apart quick. The board and clubs need to continue to work hard and encourage kids to get off the couch and enjoy running around with mates.

MAX: What would your advice be to any young or old aspiring future chairman of the league?

PETER: Run a mile! Haha! Be open minded and be prepared for anything. Everyday and every phone call is different. Be a good listener and be prepared to make tough decisions. Not everyone will be happy but you need to govern 10 clubs. ■
