But, a huge five goals to one final quarter from the Bombers saw them fall just four points short from victory. **Adrian Murray** booted three goals for the winners, with **Sean O'Neill** named best on ground. **Jaden Angus** booted three goals and **Shane Theodore** was named best on ground for the Bombers.

Simpson produced a big 105-point **Heytesbury Shield** win over rival, **Otway Districts**. **Jonno Jennings** was a star up forward, booting four goals and was named among the best players. **Shaun Harrington** kicked a goal for the Dees.

Benny Cox kicked four goals in South Colac's big 39-point win over **Alvie**. The Roos dominated all afternoon, with **Luke Burnett** named best on ground.

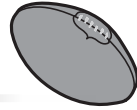

The KING of Queens

Dave Boyce made history last year for Irrewarra-Beeac, being their first male coach to lead them to premiership glory. We spoke to him this week, as they prepare to unfurl their 2023 premiership flag. Words - **MAX BLAKE**.



MAX BLAKE: Dave, thanks for chatting to us, today. Can you believe we are already into Round 3 of our new season?! How's everything going so far?

DAVE BOYCE: Max, it's felt like the season took ages to commence to be honest. For us, having the game versus Alvie, then the bye round, then round 1 game versus Birre, then another bye round last week, feels a little disjointed. But, we're looking forward to getting into the flow of the season.

Playing regular games now will be good for us as a group. We have some different combinations to work on, and things I think we need to get better at to keep competitive. It takes time for that to gel and settle.

MAX: How was returning after winning the premiership? Has the motivation been the same?

DAVE: The motivation changes a little. Last year, was the motivation to get the Premiership that had

eluded them. Now, the motivation takes a different shape, as it's about going back-to-back. But, it's also about focusing on some keys areas where we know we can improve and be more consistent and building new combinations. That's what it's going to take to be right up there this year.

MAX: Take us back to the premiership Dave, what a game! Winning with the last shot must have been an amazing feeling. What are some of your great memories of the match? Any defining moments?

DAVE: It sure was, and a game I never once thought we were out of. Even when we were down by eight goals or so.

The girls kept their composure and focused on controlling what they could. My message was to keep it simple, control the ball and chip away and you just never know what might happen.

To win it like that on the siren, was incredible. So much planning,

work and conversation around bringing home the trophy, all of a sudden was a reality. It was such a relief and such a sense of relishing in the moment.

Some of my great memories are seeing and hearing the incredible support from family, friends and the whole Irrewarra-Beeac community.

To see them cheering us on, the junior footy players lined up along the fence, cheering everything that went our way. Seeing relief and happiness on the girls' faces is something they've been chasing, was finally captured.

I knew how much that win meant to each of them and I felt so privileged and thankful to help them achieve it.

I just sat back and watched them soak it all in. We all feel on the ground together, hugging, crying and laughing. It was an amazing time.

MAX: Who was MVP of the celebrations?

DAVE: Haha, good question! The celebrations went long into the night and continued at the clubrooms the next day.

Unfortunately, I wasn't there for much of it, as I headed off, on a six-week Europe trip, early Sunday. So, I wasn't party to all that went on, but each and every one of them made the most of it, that is for sure.

MAX: What got you into coaching netball?

DAVE: My daughter, Stephanie. She was in the Vic State U17 and U19 teams and I took her to most of her training sessions.

I was coaching basketball and had been for years, and we also had a family and friends mixed netball team.

Steph thought it was a good idea and mentioned it to Justine, the East Geelong A Grade coach. We talked and I was taken on as assistant coach for A and B Grades. We won B Grade that year, and I became co-coach with Justine, the following year.

I always loved netball, both watching my daughter and playing mixed. So, with my basketball coaching background, I thought it would be great to see how I could help. It's gone pretty well.

MAX: Was it an easy transition? What were some challenges?

DAVE: The biggest challenge was not having a background in netball, where you're coached and get to understand skill breakdowns and systems.

The people and organisational side of coaching was fine, and that was very beneficial from the get-go. I undertook the netball coaching courses, asked lots of questions, listened and learned and did my own learning online.

I try to keep things as simple as I can, and never try to teach something that I don't believe or don't have a deep enough understanding.

MAX: So, what led you down the highway to our great league, and the awesome club of Irrewarra-Beeac?

DAVE: I was selling up in Geelong, and moving down to Colac to be with my partner and now, wife and Irrewarra-Beeac just happened to be looking for a new senior A Grade coach for the following season.

I sent in my résumé, had a meeting with some of the club netball committee and the then A Grade captain, and I was offered the role of both A and B Grade coach.

So, I had a family connection to the club and knew what a fabulous family orientated community it was, so I was very hopeful I would be able to coach there.

MAX: How was coaching the great Rachel Rodger? How do plan on working together?

DAVE: Coaching Rach Rodger! Well, that was a pleasure. Despite all her experience and knowledge

of the game, she was so open to my thinking on things and being co-captain, she was a fantastic person for me to bounce things off. She was, and still is, highly respected by her teammates and the opposition. She was so driven to win, and her generalship on the court was second to none.

At this early stage of coaching together, she hasn't been available much on Thursday night training, due to work commitments, but we talk a lot and discuss what we see on game-day. Her insight is great and she sees things I don't. I'm really enjoying coaching together, and I think that will continue to grow throughout the season.

MAX: What's impressed you most about the club and the league?

DAVE: What's impressed me about the club, is the family and community feel. So many amazing people who love their footy and netball, come together to make it as fun as possible, whilst also keeping the will to win, high up there.

As far as the league is concerned, I haven't had much to do with, but everything runs well and there is good support for the clubs. ■

This weekend's *Volunteer Focus* is the the Saturday Scoreboard workers. For junior games, normally it's one of the parents and for the reserves and seniors, a frequent club volunteer.

The scoreboard person is almost as important as the players out on the field. It probably comes with more pressure than the umpires. Those scores have to be correct, to make sure all the players and spectators know who is winning.

Some clubs have the bonus of have a LCD scoreboard, but some clubs roll with magnets, or the traditional steel numbers that hang on the behind glass.

Otway Districts live on the dangerous side. They even have a spot for a total score, which puts added pressure on the scoreboard volunteers to add up the scores. ■
