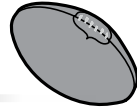

The Western Eagles are on their biggest winning run in over a decade. As they prepare for their first home game of the season this weekend, we spoke to new coach, **Dan Casey** during the week. Words - **MAX BLAKE**.

**MAX BLAKE:** Thanks for chatting to us today, Dan. How are things going at the Western Eagles?

**DAN CASEY:** G'day Maxy! Everything is going pretty well, mate. Our numbers are fantastic and the boys are playing some good footy at the moment.

**MAX:** You must be happy with the start of the season? 2-1 has to be the best start for the Western Eagles since 2013?

**DAN:** Yes, very happy, mate. We've change the game plan around a fair bit. We've been doing a lot of craft to help with limiting turnovers.

The boys have been working hard on their fitness and skills, so it's great to get rewards along the way.

**MAX:** What have been some things that have impressed you about the club?

**DAN:** I can't get over how many

supporters there are, for a small club!

I can understand why so many people want to play netball and football there.

They are so inclusive and a friendly group. I always say to our football group how resilient they are for staying committed to the Eagles, with limited success.

The netballers are flying and our junior program has and is doing really well and is well coached.

**MAX:** Who are some of the players that have impressed you so far?

**DAN:** Obviously, we have the usual suspects in James Beasley, Scott Anderson, Elijah Reid, Luke Fish. But, I'm really impressed with Tyler George's start. Tully Borgia and Jack Fish are both 16 year olds, playing good senior football at the moment.

Our Geelong boys, Mitch Helmore, Charlie Friend and James

Carter who have returned this year have been playing well also.

But, overall our whole group has improved 20 percent, so we don't need to rely on two-four players each week.

**MAX:** What motivated you to take on the coaching job at the Western Eagles?

**DAN:** A family friend, Pat Borgia is in the footy department and asked me halfway through the season last year.

I was still thinking about staying at Cobden, as the group were flying and we all put so much work into making the finals!

But, with our eldest daughter playing basketball in Melbourne Friday nights and everything else that is going on, it was too hard to travel 45 mins twice a week and then over an hour each Saturday!

I'm pretty sure I told Pat no about nine times, but with our kids playing netball and Siobhan, my wife playing and coaching I

thought if I can help in anyway I would.

I'm totally glad I said yes, as we are only three rounds in and the group have definitely improved so much.

I'm loving every minute of it!

**MAX: What do you enjoy most about coaching footy?**

**DAN:** Developing the young and old players, implementing a game plan during pre-season that is built around what strengths our players have, and watching it unfold during the game and in season. But, mostly of all the relationships you make between players, coaches, committees, trainers, juniors families and supporters.

You have life-long friendships and memories on and off field.

**MAX: What are some challenges to coaching?**

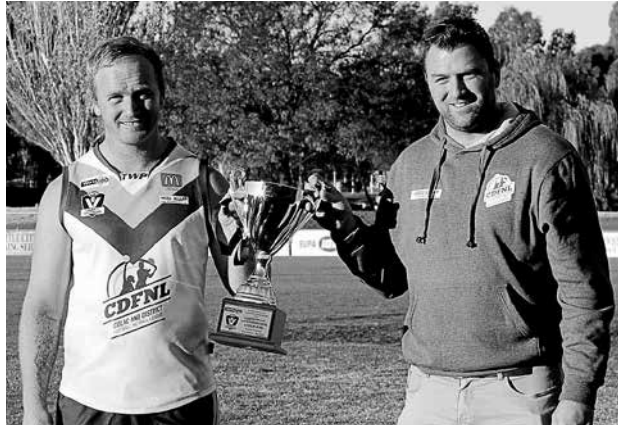
**DAN:** The challenges come from the off-field challenges that the group faces.

Everything can be going fantastic, then something happens in a player's or supporter's private life and that's where they need the support from us to have at least a few hours break from what's going on.

As a friend of Paul Liistro (Imperials coach), he is facing these challenges at the moment with the club dealing with the passing of Jesse (Lucas), which is a really tough time.

Football and netball clubs are such an amazing support place. Footy is supposed to be fun and sometimes we forget this!

**MAX: You've coached a number of teams in different leagues.**

**Who have been some of the best players you've coached and why?**

**DAN:** Wow, that's a good question!

I loved playing with Kahn Beckett at Irrewarra-Beeac and Camperdown. He was such a strong skilful player. Also, Tony Walker and Rob Elborough. They were both fantastic players. Pete Featherston. He was such a great player. Season 2010 was fantastic to play in a flag with him.

Lochie Rosevear, Lachy Mulder and Tyler Flanagan, they were always strong juniors, but when they played seniors at such a young age they've an impact. Now they are dominant senior players!

The Scott brothers, Cam and Bailey are such talented players. They can change a game by themselves. Bloody good players!

At Cobden, I was blessed to

coach Paul Pekin, who was tough, smart and a game changer.

Same as Patty Smith and Grady Rooke, both fantastic players

My favourite was big Mick Koronaus. He is the last of the really big powerful full forwards. On debut, he kicked seven goals, I think. I loved working with him.

**MAX: Do you take notes from how some AFL or your past coaches go about it? Or do you have your own way and style?**

**DAN:** I take a lot of notice from past and opposition coaches. I love chatting to them regarding what they thought we did well, where they thought they played well, etc. That way we can learn from that.

I speak a lot with Nev Swayn from Camperdown and Paul Liistro from the Imps. ■
