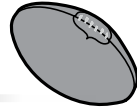

Is it time the CDFNL names our top goal kicking award?

Polarising figure Christian Kelly has been one of the CDFNL's greatest ever players. He's kicked the most goals by any player in the league's history. He's represented the league at interleague level and produced greatness in those games. He's performed on the big stage kicking goals in Grand Finals, and as his twilight years draw closer, he's still kicking bags during the

12 O'Clock show at Alvie as a returning recruit. Last weekend, he booted nine against Apollo Bay, taking his impressive career total to 1,400 goals from 324 games across multiple leagues.

Over the years, the CDFNL Board has named some of their highest awards after stars of our league.

The A Grade League Best and Fairest Award is named the Val Russell Medal, while Best on Ground in the

senior football Grand Final is the Peter Featherson Medal.

So, I believe the time is right, to name our goal kicking award after a league champion - and without a doubt, that clearly must be Christian Kelly!

What a humbling way to finish up his playing days than naming an award he has won multiple times as the league's greatest goalkicker. ■

Chris Dell has been a part of the Irrewarra-Beeac FNC for a long time. With Mother's Day tomorrow, we caught up with her during the week. Words - **MAX BLAKE**.

MAX BLAKE: Thanks for chatting to us today, Chris. Happy Mothers Day weekend! How are things going so far at Irrewarra-Beeac this season?

CHRIS DELL: All going well here! Thank you for the Mother's Day wishes. Everyone is up and about and supporting each other at Irrewarra-Beeac. With our six footy teams and seven netball teams, there are plenty of parent helpers around to pitch in and help out.

MAX: What makes Irrewarra-Beeac such a great club?

CHRIS: To me, it's the family atmosphere. Having no kids living in Colac, they are my winter family. Everyone is always friendly and ready for a catch up and chat.

MAX: What got you involved in volunteering at the club?

CHRIS: A Legend at our club by the name of Jason ('Toza') Cartwright. We love him dearly. In Secondary School he invited my eldest son, Brendan to come along and play Youth Club footy, as it was called back then. And, the rest, as they say is history. I started out being the timekeeper every week on a Sunday morning.

All three of my kids have played in juniors and seniors at Warra. Two of them winning Grand Finals, playing in the Reserves.

So, Toza ..thank you.

MAX: You're now the CEO of the club ...well that's what I call you! What keeps you motivated to

continue to volunteer at the Bombers?

CHRIS: I love doing, what I'm doing. I get along well with the coaches and players. Having been Secretary for 15 years (not CEO!), I can answer most questions off the top of my head. I'm thanked weekly by a few people as to how much work I really do, so that makes me feel appreciated and wanting to return again the next week.

MAX: Tell me what your game-day Saturday involves? What time does your day start and end, and what's involved in between?

CHRIS: Oh dear!!!! My Saturday starts on a Thursday!

THURSDAY

Upload teams and print out Under-14.5 and Under-18 team sheets. Get all paperwork/vote cards/scoresheets/awards ready to hand to Team Managers on Thursday night.

Collect laundered footy jumpers and washing from Rosie's Drycleaners and oranges from Garden of Eden to distribute to each team.

Head to the club at 5:15pm, help with some preparations for teas, then serve. Wait for announcements of Saturdays senior teams, so I can get team sheets done on Friday. Get home about 9pm, ready for a well earned coffee (6hrs).

FRIDAY

Select teams and print team sheets from *PlayHQ* and prepare all other paperwork for Seniors and Reserves. Sort footy jumpers into team bags (3 hrs).

SATURDAY (GAME-DAY)

Up at 7.30am on game-day. Head to club at 8am. Empty car of usually six bags of 'stuff'.

Get computers up and operating ready for entering results. Normal home game paperwork.

Look after trainers with food/drinks and snacks throughout the day, as they are volunteers... just like me.

Enter all results from football matches. I do get to sit and watch the Senior game, as I do the live scoring at home games, each week.

General tidy up and lock up at the club, before a few of us might go out for dinner after the footy. I get home about 9pm, after dropping all the footy jumpers and other laundry off to Rosie's.

Empty the car of all the other



incidentals. I carry new shorts and socks in my car and anything else that might be needed to play a game of footy every week. Ready for a coffee again!

MAX: Do you get to watch much of the games on game-day?

CHRIS: I might get to see half of each match, and have a chat to a few parents, but I get to see all the seniors as I'm doing the live scoring.

MAX: Who have been some of your favourite players come through the club?

CHRIS: Starting with my own sons of course, Brendan, Aaron and Shaun. Lachie Boyd was like my fourth son, so I enjoyed supporting and watching him. Sam and Jack Barrow use to be favourites, as well. 'Toza' was always up there. I also liked watching Tony Walker, Khan Beckett, Rob Elborough, Travis Sell, Troy Keating and 'Bluey' Angus.

MAX: Do you think it's harder to get volunteers to help out these days? How does Irrewarra-Beeac go trying to get new helpers?

CHRIS: On the football side of things, most of our junior parents are great to put their hands up when there are things required

to be done. It's in the senior and reserves games, where sometimes it's the same people doing the same jobs week in, week out. The canteen girls are always on the lookout for volunteers to help out. Even the juniors - both boys and girls put their hands up and help out for a few hours.

It's the age old saying 'Many hands make light work'.

MAX: Who's your favourite opposition club and why?

CHRIS: I think it would be Imps. I get along very well with Carl (Winchcomb), as I can speak my mind to him. And 'Simo' (John Simpson) as well. He's been around for a few years, just like me.

Both my parents were Life Members at Imps, and my brother played for Imps back when their home ground was at the showgrounds.

MAX: Lastly, if your kids are reading this, what would your ideal Mother's Day celebration be?

CHRIS: My Ideal Mother's Day would be to all share in a meal together as a family. With Brendan and his wife and two daughters living in Darwin I know that's not going to happen. But, I'm heading up there next week on our 'Bye' weekend. ■

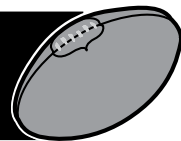

This round, there are five big ladder-shaping games this weekend, with movement around the ladder expected.

Lorne have had a very impressive start to the season and look the side most likely to challenge Alvie for the flag. But today, the Dolphins face a fired up South Colac side who have lost their last two games. Should the Kangaroos lose today, it could see them slipping out of the top 5 with a 2-3 win/loss record.
