Swans win top of the table clash

Alvie and South Colac went head-to-head on a sunny afternoon at Elliminyt. Both sides went into the Round 6 clash undefeated in 2021 and produced a high-class match.

The Swans had the Roos' measure all afternoon, but South Colac were able to get within three points at the final change. However, a six goal to two final quarter saw Alvie march onto a 15.7 (97) to 10.9 (69) victory. **Dom Dare** kicked six and **Pat Seal** three, with **Ben Lynch** and **Lochie Rosevear** named best on the ground for the winners. **Josh Black** booted four goals for the Kangaroos.

Birregurra produced a shock, thrilling victory over **Lorne** at the Pod. In what was low scoring game to three-quarter-time, with both sides locked on 32 points a piece. The Saints kicked four goals to three in the final term to score a great away win. Birregurra's win was helped by its' amazing kicking for goal. The Saints scoring 9.2 (56) to the Dolphins' 7.11 (53). **Jack Moorfoot** and **Sam Green** each kicked two for the winners, while **Alex Burnett** was named best on ground. **'Big Lewie Hollmer'** booted four goals for Lorne.

The **Western Eagles** produced a thrilling seven-point victory over **Otway Districts**. The two sides exchanged the lead all afternoon, but the Eagles were able to hold for the 7.7 (49) to 6.6 (42) win. **Jake Vandongen** kicked four goals for the Eagles, with **Angus Reid** best on ground. Former Eagle, **Paddy Ryan** kicked two goals for the Dees.

Tom McKay kicked five goals against his old side the Tigers, to help the **Colac Imperials** produce a 28-point win over **Simpson**. The Imps trailed at



half-time by seven points, but a nine goal to three second-half saw them record a 13.11 (89) to 8.13 (61) victory.

Irrewarra-Beeac had a massive 32 scoring shots against **Apollo Bay**, but only managed to kick 11 goals in their 19-point win over the Hawks. The Bombers kicked 11.21 (87) to 11.2 (68), with **Tyler Flanigan** kicking three goals in a best on ground performance. ■

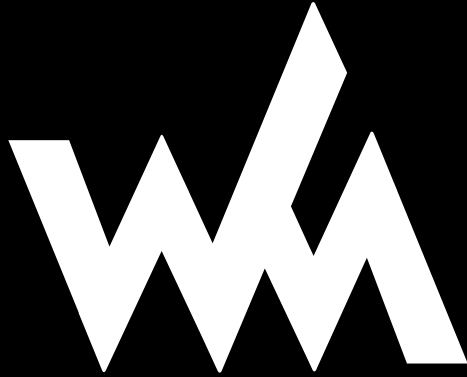

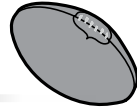

'BAY LEGEND, Harro'



Apollo Bay club legend, **Michael Harrison** is pumped for another premiership reunion this weekend. We spoke to him in the lead up. Words - **MAX BLAKE**.

MAX BLAKE: 'Harro', thanks for chatting to us today, mate. What does the Coastal Cup mean to you these days?

MICHAEL HARRISON: The Coastal Cup is important, but not what it used to be for me. Now it's more of a chance to catch up with old mates that I played with and against.

MAX: What did it use to be like?

MICHAEL: Very passionate! Lorne were and so were we. The games were very physical, no matter the ladder positions of either side. There used to be some great punch ups as well!

MAX: Why do you think the rivalry just isn't the same as it was, back in the day?

MICHAEL: Football is more of a business now. It used to be more town v town, mostly made up of local players who had played at

the clubs for most of their lives. The clubs still try and educate the kids and new players about the history and rivalry though.

MAX: What was the most memorable Coastal Cup game that you were involved in, and why?

MICHAEL: There haven't been any real stand out Coastal Cups. They were all played with the same spirit, but I suppose any games that you won, when you weren't expected to, were always great fun.

MAX: Who were some of your toughest Lorne opponents you played against, and why?

MICHAEL: I played a lot of games against the late great, Dick Davies, Rob Dalziel, Gav Griffiths - they were always hard opponents. Geoff Balderas, the late Mark Trickey, David Wyles were all good

players. A bit like the 'Bay team, I could go on and on, about great players for Lorne.

MAX: This weekend the Hawks have the 1984 and 2004 premiership reunions. You guys had some great players in those flags - both wins against Lorne. What does it mean to you to be a part of these reunions?

MICHAEL: It means everything! A bloody lot of blood, sweat and tears go into winning flags! You make a lot of great friendships, so it's fantastic to catch up with old mates.

MAX: What was Rahni Buchanan like as a player? He snagged seven in the 2004 premiership win.

MICHAEL: Brilliant, he never stopped running. A bit like Steve Morsehead in '84. Both running machines with a fantastic skillset.

The Buchanans were a very well blessed sporting family.

MAX: Who were some of the best players you've seen play at the 'Bay? You're welcome to name yourself!

MICHAEL: Hahaha, that won't be happening! It would be unfair to name them. There are so many players to be honest. I've had so many talented teammates over the journey and wouldn't like to leave anybody out, sorry mate! The 1984 team had some rippers. It was a big tall team with a lot of strength in a lot of areas. The 2004 team also had plenty of star power, led by 'Spike Michael Parker'.

MAX: Who would win if the 1984 flag team played the 2004 flag winners?

MICHAEL: Stop that line of questioning! Hahaha, you always think your own era's were better! But, it is so hard to pick, as the game changes so much every year. So, 20 years apart, the games are nearly unrecognisable.

MAX: What are your thoughts on footy these days?

MICHAEL: It's OK, most clubs try and copy AFL, and in my opinion there is too many rotations. Players spend more time running to the bench to have a rest. Sometimes four to five minutes into a quarter, surely you couldn't be tired, already?!

MAX: It must be great seeing your boys, Harrison and Ashton playing senior footy at the 'Bay?

MICHAEL: Yes, it's enjoyable to see! Hudson and Ashton are trying like all the other local boys to get
